RULES

I

¶The name of the Society shall be THE PILGRIMS.

II

¶The object of the Society shall be the promotion of the sentiment of brotherhood among the nations, and especially the cultivation of good fellowship between citizens of the United States and its dependencies and subjects of the British Empire.

III

¶The officers shall be a President, Vice-Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer, elected annually by the Executive Committee, who together with twenty-one other members, shall constitute the Executive Committee of the Society.

IV

¶The members shall be citizens of the United States or its dependencies or subjects of the British Empire, and others prominent for their sympathy with the objects of the Society, who

shall be elected by the Executive Committee, and membership in the London Pilgrims shall ipso facto constitute membership in the New York Society, and vice versa without additional dues.

¶The membership shall be limited to nine hundred. This number may be altered by the Executive Committee.

¶Any one whom the Executive Committee consider worthy of the honor may be elected an honorary member of the Society.

¶No honorary member shall be eligible to serve on the Committee, or hold any Executive office.

V

¶Candidates must be proposed by one member and seconded by another, both of whom shall inform the Committee in writing as to the eligibility of the candidate. A candidate must be personally known to at least one member of the Committee on Admissions. The candidate's full name and occupation shall be entered in a form to be provided for the purpose, which shall be signed by the proposer and seconder. The election for membership shall be by the Executive Committee upon recommendation from the Committee on Admissions.

¶The Committee on Admissions shall cause to be mailed to every member of the Executive Committee a list of the candidates, with the

names of the proposer and seconder at least two weeks before these names are reported to the Executive Committee for action.

¶The election shall be by ballot; one black ball in five shall exclude. If twice rejected, a candidate cannot again be put up for election without the unanimous consent of the Committee.

¶The Secretary shall notify each new member of his election, and furnish him with a copy of the Rules.

VI

¶The Executive Committee upon vote of eleven of its members may at any time cancel the membership of any member; and refuse to receive the subscription of any member, and such ex-member shall not have the right to make any appeal whatsoever nor to demand the reasons for such cancellation.

VII

¶There shall be an Executive Committee, in whose hands the management of the Society and the enforcing of these Rules shall be vested; and they shall have power to add to, or alter these rules after giving two weeks' notice to each member of the Committee of the proposal to so add to or alter the same.

¶The Committee shall make all such rules and regulations as they shall from time to time think

necessary for the management and well-being of the Society, and for carrying out its objects, and such rules and regulations shall be binding on all members of the Society.

¶One-third of the Committee shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Society and hold office for three years, one-third retiring each year, and be eligible for re-election.

¶The Committee shall appoint annually from their own number a chairman.

¶Five members of the Committee shall form a quorum.

¶The Committee shall have power to fill vacancies in its membership.

¶The Committee shall appoint annually from their own number a Finance Committee, consisting of three members, who shall be responsible to the Executive Committee to whom they shall report annually, or oftener if requested, by the Executive Committee.

¶The Committee shall appoint annually from their own number a Committee on Admissions consisting of three members, to which Committee the names of candidates for elections shall be referred.

¶The Committee shall have power to appoint sub-committees for any purposes or objects, and to delegate to such sub-committee the functions

and powers of the Committee relating to the same.

¶The President and the Secretary of the Society shall be ex-officio members of all Committees.

¶Any member of the Executive Committee who shall be absent from three successive meetings without excuse or explanation may be deemed to have resigned and his place may be filled by the Executive Committee.

VIII

¶The members of the Committee on Admissions shall not propose or second the names of any candidates for election to the Society.

IX

¶No member shall be liable for any amount beyond his entrance fee and annual subscription.

X

¶At any meeting, whether general or in committee, the Chairman shall have a casting vote, except at the election of a member, when he shall have only one vote.

XI

¶There shall be an annual meeting of the Society held on the fourth Wednesday of each January, at such place as the Committee may select, two weeks' notice of such meeting to be given by the Secretary.

XII

¶There shall be no entrance fee at present, but each member shall pay an annual subscription of Ten Dollars (\$10) on or before February first of each year.

XIII

¶All subscriptions shall be paid to the Treasurer, who shall keep the accounts of the Society.

¶He shall render a statement of the accounts at each annual meeting, which shall have been duly audited by the Finance Committee.

¶Any member not paying his subscription two calendar months after it becomes due, shall not be permitted to make use of the Society, except by permission of the Executive Committee; and if a member's subscription be three months in arrears, he shall cease to be a member of the Society.

¶The Executive Committee may reinstate a member on a satisfactory explanation of failure of due payment.

XIV

¶All members shall from time to time communicate to the Secretary their own addresses or those of their agents or bankers, and all notices sent to such addresses shall be considered as duly delivered.

¶The Secretary shall keep a book in which such addresses shall be entered.

XV

¶No member shall make use of the name or address of the Society for advertising purposes, nor shall the name of the Society be used on letterheads or otherwise for any purposes except those of the Society, nor by any but Officers and Committees thereof.

XVI

¶Members desiring to resign must notify the Secretary of such intention one calendar month before the date of the next annual subscription becomes due, otherwise they will be liable for the usual subscription for the ensuing year.

XVII

¶Members may introduce their friends to the public meetings of the Society, subject to such restrictions as the Committee may from time to time establish.

XVIII

¶The decision of the Executive Committee on all matters relating to the Society shall be final.
