BAFFLED stargazers were today trying to unravel the truth behind a mystery object seen in the skies over Lincoln.

Residents in the Boultham Park Road area were left 21 APR 97 scratching their heads after tracking a bright flashing object for more than half an hour as they scanned the skies for a glimpse of the Hale-Bopp comet

Brian Blades (58), of Boultham Park Road, was so startled when he saw the UFO, he went round to neighbours' homes to see what they made of it.

"I was looking for the comet through binoculars when my attention was caught by a series of bright lights high in the sky," he said,

"They were flashing red, green and white. All I can liken it to is like the lights you get at a disco. It definitely wasn't an aeropiane, it was too high up and moving too slowly.

went round to my neighbours and they'd seen exactly the same thing. It was a round rotating object and we're all at a loss to explain what it was."

The object was first spotted at around 9.30pm on Friday. After watching it until just by Jason Mellor

after 10pm, residents say it disappeared over Waddington towards Newark.

"I've always been very sceptical about this kind of thing, but now I'm not so sure. Maybe there is some-thing out there after all," added Mr Blades who has lived in the area for 30 years.

The report is the latest in a string of mystery sightings in the county's skies — believed to be a hotbed of UFO activity - in the past few months.

One of the most notable sightings late last year was a mystery object tracked by RAF radar along the county's coast, which was also recorded on video by Skegness police.

Rescue nysterv

A SALE UFO expert claims there has been a cover-up to hide the truth about a myscrash in the Peak terv District.

Stephen Mera believes a top secret military aircraft came down there last month - and that the armed services immediately swooped to clear up the wreckage.

His group MAPIT - Manchester Phenomena Anomalous

Investigation Team - has been probing the 'crash' near the Ladybower Reservoir in the Peak District since there were reports of people hearing a loud explosion and seeing a white flash of light, at around 10pm on Monday, March

Stephen, of Paignton Drive, Ashton on Mersey, believes the search and rescue operation launched involved police, mountain rescue teams, the RAF and Army.

A recording was also made of a sonic boom in Leeds at just after 10pm on March 24 which Stephen believes was made by a military aircraft.

He says: "I believe the incident at Ladybower may have been a top secret military air-craft coming down in the area.

A South Yorkshire Police spokesman says:
"We received several reports from people who believed they had seen a light aircraft going down. We launched a seven hour search nvolving search and rescue teams and an RAF Sea King helicopter. But we did not find anything.



UFOs are out there... in Otley

UFO WATCHERS in Otley are burning the midnight oil to produce a veritable "bible" of flying saucer history.

Next month marks the 50th anniversary of the first use of the term "flying saucer", which was coined by a journalist following a sighting of airborne discs.

And UFO Magazine – which is produced by a staff of eight at Wharfebank House, Ilkley Road, Otley – will celebrate the occasion with a bumper 104-page issue, 30 pages more than usual.

Some 150,000 copies will be printed – almost double the normal print-run – and thousands will be distributed nationally and internationally.

Editor Graham Birdsall said: "We have received orders for this issue from all over the world, from Holland to the Philippines, and we hope it will become a reference work used even by Ministry of Defence.

"It will show people that there is a huge history of UFOs and it may persuade them to find out more." Graham said that he and his workers – he has recently taken on two more assistants – have been working up to 15 hours a day to prepare for publication on Thursday, May 29.

He will give an overview of the last 50 years at the 16th Leeds International UFO Conference, to be held at Leeds University from September 19 to 21.

There will be eight speakers at the event, some of them coming from as far afield as Mexico, Germany and the United States.
