SPECIAL REPORT ON OTTAWA POLICE CHIEF PETER STOLY (Part One)

The Chief of Police for the City of Ottawa is Peter Stoly. In addition to that role, he also has major connections to corporatist interests such as accounting and consulting giant Deloitte. This firm employs approximately 334,000 people on a global basis.¹ One of his bios states that he is/was an Executive Director at Deloitte Canada.²

Freedom Convoy 2022 assesses that Chief Stoly, following his evidence-free attack on the convoy to the benefit of Prime Minister Trudeau and Mayor Watson, has played a role in creating a political space where violence can occur. This contradicts his early statements that the situation in Ottawa is political in nature and requires a political solution.

According to Deloitte's own statements "Peter Sloly is a security and justice thought leader and trusted C-suite advisor who leads Deloitte Canada's national "Security & Justice" (S&J) practice." He is also a graduate from the FBI Academy, which currently raises questions by itself. In other words, Chief Stoly he is/was deeply embedded with senior executives at major corporations and US government institutions. ³

We appreciate that Chief Stoly is in a difficult situation. He is caught between an absentee Prime Minister with an Ottawa Mayor who advocates for institutionalized violence against the convoy and an emerging movement with global support. Still, he needs to declare his potential conflicts of interest with corporatist power structures. His cooperation in providing Go Fund Me with false information to close down the Freedom Convoy account raise concerns about his future with the Ottawa Police Service.

Freedom Convoy 2022 would also like to take this chance to state that cooperation with front line police officers from multiple forces remains high. Front line officers have also been exposed to pressure from multiple fronts and have always remained professional.

If you are a convoy member, a supporter, or a citizen, walk over and say hello to any uniformed police officer and see the person behind the badge.
