NOTICE OF DETERMINATION CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

- On various dates between 29 February 2016 and 19 December 2017 the Crown Prosecution Service (the 'CPS') was designated as a core participant in the following investigations: The Anglican Church; Cambridge House, Knowl View and Rochdale; The late Lord Janner of Braunstone QC; Lambeth Council; Nottinghamshire Councils; and, Westminster. Alastair Tidball of the Government Legal Department ('GLD') was designated as the CPS' recognised legal representative.
- 2. On 30 November 2018 the Inquiry was informed that Mr Tidball's responsibilities within GLD would be changing and that Laura Tams of the CPS would be replacing him as the CPS' legal representative in relation to the above investigations.
- Accordingly, as I am satisfied that the CPS has now appointed Laura Tams as its qualified lawyer, I designate Ms Tams as its recognised legal representative in the above investigations in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006 as I am required by that rule to do.
