



INDEPENDENT INQUIRY CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 29 February 2016, 24 August 2017 and 19 December 2017, the Home Office was designated as a core participant in each of the Inquiry's following investigations: the investigation into institutional responses to allegations of child sexual abuse involving the late Lord Janner of Braunstone QC; the investigation into institutional responses to child sexual abuse and exploitation facilitated by the Internet; the investigation into allegations of child sexual abuse and exploitation involving people of prominence associated with Westminster. Sarah Townsend of the Government Legal Department (GLD) was designated as the Home Office's recognised legal representative.
2. On 8 June 2018, the Inquiry was informed that Ms Townsend's responsibilities within GLD have changed and so Daniel Rapport would be acting as the Home Office's legal representative in relation to the above investigations with immediate effect.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that the Home Office has now appointed Daniel Rapport of GLD as its qualified lawyer, I designate Mr Rapport as its recognised legal representative in the above investigations in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006 as I am required by that rule to do.
