GEORGE had been with captioned organization as a photographer during the attack on the Russian freighter "Baku" at Caye Caibarien, Cuba, on the night of 3/26/63. SCHWANITZ had received a UPI newscast about this attack and had contacted his source in Miami to determine if this person, described by him as an individual of Cuban nationality in that area, had any information about same. This person indicated he had reliable information that ST. GEORGE had been in on the attack and that the original information received by the source that he was present during the 3/17/63 action by ALPHA 66 had not been confirmed.
