Reference is made to paragraphs 2 and 3 on page 13, wherein it is indicated that investigative techniques resulted in identifying the "Lancastrian Prince" as a vessel on which a bomb had been placed. This was reported in this manner in order to protect MM 1337-S, who actually furnished this information which he obtained on a highly confidential basis from BOSCH. MM 1337-S is still of great value to this office.

This case was not submitted earlier as an interesting case write-up because the defendants appealed their convictions almost immediately after the trial.

On 7/9/71, AUSA RICHARD HAUSER, Miami, advised that no notice has been received by his office indicating that attorneys for the defendants have taken steps to appeal the decision of the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals to the U.S. Supreme Court.
