## June 10, 1965

Valjean Matthew Haley, West Palm Beach, Florida, received 3 seperate communications from MINUTEMEN in the recent past. The exact dates he received them are not known. They were as follows:

One was postmarked in Lexington, Missouri, on an illegible date. It included a copy of "On Target" dated March, 1965; a "Bulletin For March" on "Reorganization" which spoke of administrative problems at MINUTENEN headquarters and the need for money and similar items, and a subscription form for "On Target".

One was postmarked at Independence, Missouri, with no date shown in the postmark. It included "Minutemen News" dated April, 1965; an article entitled "Blue Print For Revolution" written by "41,339" which had to do with the activities and preachings of General Bayo, who was described as a communist, and how Fidel Castro followed those teachings, and an article applauding the stand of Congressman Bob Casey (Texas) on legislation regarding firearms pending before Congress.

The last was postmarked in Lawrence, Kansas, with no date visible in the postmark. It contained copies of "On Target" for April and May, 1965, one of which had to do with procommunist student groups in universities, and a pamphlet entitled "Venceremos".

Each of the above communications also contained a "Member's Report": I for March, I for April and I for May. These reports are designed to be used to forward monthly dues of \$2.00; for ordering training programs at listed cost, and for reporting on ones monthly activities. Haley returned all of these to MINUTEMEN with the required monthly dues; ordered the 2nd phase training program, and pointed out to MINUTEMEN, in answer to a question on the form, that he had mover been assigned to a "band" or "team".

This is the only contact Haley has had with Minutemen in the past few months. He has never had personal contact with a member of the organization to his knowledge.
