- Cal, concerning Eunice CDIO. 1. Reference is made to your cable (24, concerning Runics CDI)
 96, 1 October 1947 stated that among the various prises given by the Quaternian Covernment for proces and postry, one price was awarded, in the last week of September to a young Costa Rican woman samed Eunice ADIO.
- 2. During her stay in Gustemala City after receiving the award, Senarita ODIO gave two recitations of beit poems. One was given in the CTO assembly hall, and the second was given before the Reculty of Humanities of the San Carlos University. There, she was presented by the Castemalan post, Miguel Angel ASTURIAS.
- 3. Miss ODIO's style is distinctly Korudian. This is not strange, as she is a very active Communist in Costa Vilus, being a member of the famous Communist literati cell - Bugenio Karia de Rostos-to which Corina Rodrigues also belongs.
- 4. Eurice ODIO was described in 1947 as being about twenty-five years of age, white, with black hair and black eyes, about five foot five inches tall, and weighing approximately 118 pounds. She is of attractive appearance and wears her hair long, which extends half way to her waist. Her platform personality is pleasing, and her voice, which is the most attractive feature, easily captivates her audiences, because of its low scothing tons.
- 5. Har fanaticies for the cause of Communism and har work and offcrts were fully appreciated by the so-called Polithuro of the Partido Vanguardia Popular in Costa Rica.

6. SANJ_133, IH_23963, 21 Hovember 1947, mentioned a letter written by Josquin CUTIERREZ Mangel, som of the Costa Rican Ambasender to Washingtone addressed to Buntos CDIO in which he species highly of Coving RURICUES, wallknown Costa Rican Communist. The source continued by saying that young

GUTIERFEZ was a suspected Communist and that his close association with Communists such as Corina RUBRIGUEZ and Eunice UDIO strengthened the suspicion.

- 7. In a rather complicated document, 1191. 18 September 1950, which went to but not to the Colombian hational Chief of Detectives, Carlos RURIGUEZ Telles reports on arms shipments in Costa Rican territory which are rumored may be intended to reach Colombia. He was sent to Costa Rica and made a general report covering the arms shipments, the involvement of the Caribbean Legion, the infiltration of the Legion by Communists, and the Costa Rican Communists who were involved. Discussing the Costa Rican Communists who had been obliged to seek sanctuary in Guatemala, Mexico and Venesuela, he listed Eunice CDIO, Costa Rican poet, Communist agitator, residing in Guatemala.
- 8. No other information concerning Eunice ODIO is available at headquarters. Also, there is no confirmation of the allegation that Eunice ODIO had been the mistress of Jacobs ARBENZ.
