Languago: Russian "I have been an emigrant and for the time being I will remain an emigrant as before. GOESUHOV and his family, SHIRIGIN and his family, SHIRIGIN and his family, LAPSHAKOVA (Ex: woman) ILIMA (Ex: woman), LEKCHTSEV and ELYKOVA (Ex: woman) are going to America. Many are going to Russia but I do not know to what place they will go.

"A few days ago the Soviet Consul made a speech for them and said that those who wish to go to Soviet Russia may do so in the near future. He also said that any who did not wish to return to Russia would not be forced to do so."

*Colonel FIGURIREDO Lima, prominent Japanophile, expert on affairs in Japan and former military observer representing Brazil during the Simo-Japanese Incident, gave a lecture here about mix (6) months ago. On that occasion he talked about the patriotic spirit of the Japanese people, and said that the last World War ended in great victory for Japan. He also told us that the greater East Asia Co-Prosperity Sphere was established and small usiatic countries became independent under the protection of Japan; science was greatly advanced in Japan compared with other countries and Japan had more powerful atomic bombs than the United States; all information reported by the newspapers was untrue.

"He concluded his speech by stressing that they, the Brasilians, had to exert themselves for the prace of the world in cooperation with Japan. Both the Brasilians and the Japanese residing in Brasil firmly believe that Japan is making propaganda of her defeat because she wants world peace, though she gained a victory in reality. By the speech of Colonel FIGUEIREDO Lima, we Japanese residents here got a ray of hope in the dark world and our mind was brightened."
