Subject: Iden A

Subject was interviewed and tested on 16 April 1964 at safe site in the Miami area at the request of Henry P. REDNOLTZ. The interview was conducted in English.

Subject has been involved with KUHAH. since 1959. Fer a peried previous to that time Subject was cooperating with ODENYY in Cube. He is currently being used by PW as a source of information on the Cuban exile community. The excuse for testing Subject was that he was being counidered for training. The actual purpose of the interview was to resolve issues raised by JAWAVE/KUDESK which are detailed in WAVE 2672, dated 26 February 1964.

Subject has worked only for AUBARK and ODENTY. He has never cooperated in any way with any intelligence service of any other country. He has never been asked to cooperate with any communist controlled intelligence service. He does not make intelligence type reports to any one other than ODYOAE. Subject has no classicatine communication with anyone outside PRPRINE. He is not in contact with anyone whom he suspects of being a Caban agent. He has mover taken part in any communist activity.

ETAILS

Subject stated that it is widely known among the Cuban exile community that he is in touch with KUBARK. The fact that this is known is partly what enables him to obtain information which is of interest to KUBARK. Subject stated that we more than four or five Americane know of his involvement with KUBARK. Among them is Idea D.

Subject was asked whether he commissed in any way with individuals litting outside of PRPRINE. He stated that the ealy individual in that category was a ferner Cuban CTC member by the mams of Idea C who presently works for the Alliance for Progress. Idea C is now believed to be in Headurar. Subject stated that his wife communicates with her family in Cuba but Subject stated that be is positive she does not disquer any of his notivities in these comunications.

Subject stated that his wife in Inlly knowledgeable of his KUMARK activities.

Subject was asked whether be bud any agreement to cooperate with may of the exile organizations. He stated that in the formal sense of the word he had no such agreement but that he was idealogically Geraltica to Amiliur/1 and the Axvallu organization. Subject stated

that he has not had any contact with A'BIDDY/1 since he was told to sever his connection in Pebruary 1963. He does, however, occasionally see MSA and BARRO. From his remarks it is quite obvious that Subject has a great deal of affection and respect for AMBIDOY/1. Subject stated that he has done nothing recently to actively support the Argumen group but that he would not besitate to tell amyone, if they naked, that he felt ANNORLD was worthy of all the support that the inquirer could give.

Subject stated that he also has a great deal of respect for the 30th of Recomber Movement. His contact with that group is Idea D. Subject has only known Idea D for about two nouths and that incidentally was the reason why Iden D's name does not appear on the list of Subject's contacts given to the Station in 1964.

Im a discussion of whether or not Subject discusses KUBARK business with unauthorized persons, Subject stated that he did not believe he was privy to what might be considered classified information bearing on KUBAKK activities. He pointed out that his information gathering activities necessitate a certain amount of give and take which involves bringing information to the attention of cortain individuals in order to check their reaction to that information. Subject has not made any deliberate effort to obtain information regarding AUBAKK activities from his contacts eneng the Cuban groups who work for KUDAUK.

In the discussion of blackmail potentialities Subject stated that he had ence been intimate with the wife of Idea E. He stated that as far as he knows Idem 5 is not aware of this, but that Idem 5 once teld him that he had compiled derogatory information regarding Subject and forwarded it to KERAPK officials.

Subject stated that he knows at least the following KUBARKers by true mann: Iden F, Iden G, Iden H, and Iden I.


Subject stared that he might recall others if he heard the mamos. Subject does not know the mamo or location of the KUBARK base in Missi.

Subject stated that he has always felt that KUBARK has considered win a Cuben anthor than an American. He wished to cake it very clear that he Jeas not comider himself a Cuban but on the contrary considers binsolt an American.

Subject stated that he felt that KUBARK was not utilizing him to the fallent extent of his abilities. " He stated that he desires to become a personnent KUNAUX paset and that he would like very such to be utilized, after the apprepriate training, in the PM field.
