A Cuban emigre with excellent contects is several emigre organisations in Miami. He has been an occurate reporter on those organizations and on general emigre political developments since about mid-1952.

- Representatives of the Miami and Puerto Rico chapters of the Centro Cubano de Estudies Politicos (CCLP. Cuban Center for Political Studies) net in Sat. Juan. Puerto Fico. on 20 August 1966 to start making plans to hold a CCLP congress. On the morning of 20 August; three delegates from Missi not with about six members of the Puerto Rico delegation for preliminary discussions on the agenda for the afternoon meeting. At this ageting Rufo Lopes Fresquet, a leader of the Puerto Rico chapter. was consured for his irreconcilable position regarding the exclusiveness of the proposed congress. Annual Pay Rivero. snother member of the Puerto Rico branch, expressed concern that Lopes' attitude would disrupt the preparations for, or jeoperdise the effectiveness of the congress. I key said that he is prepared to disband the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE, Cuban Revolutionary Junta). Lut will not do se until there is assurance that the CCLP will become an effective organization. Lopez received applause when he addressed the group, and promised to refrein from creating difficulties for the CCLP. and to devote his time and energy toward making the congress 2 Success.
- 2. The following agreements were reached at the afternoon meeting, which was attended by about 20 members of the Puerto Rico chapter and the three delegates from Himmi:
 - a. The Congreso Ravolucionario Cubano (Cuban Revolutionary Congress) will be held in Miami from 2 to 5 February 1967.

The ajence, and rules soverning the clivility requirements for attendance, will be prepared in acrence.

- b. A "Declaration of Principles" of the CCIP, which will set forth the purpose and goels of the organization, will to written.
- c. CCLF casptero will be established in hew York. Los Angeles. and Chicago, and in Caracas. Venezuela.
- B. Has Leanick beneades, a dieni delegate, was designated to prepare a reject on the results of the neeting which will be sussitted to the Puerto Rico CCEP for approvel: after which a public discouncement on the position of the CCEP will be made.
- the CCLP in miami delegates went to Puerto Rico, the masters of the CCLP in miami held discussions to determine the position of their organization on the tolics which were to be discussed. It was agreed that the Miami chapter would favor holding a conscress which would be solely for the purpose of consolidating and advancing the CCLP. The creation of a Partido de la Revolucion Cubana (PRC Party of the Cuban Revolution), a proposed political party, should not be considered at the congress. In early August some members of the Powrto Rico chapter expressed their agreement with the position of the Miami chapter.

Source Comments

- A "major problem" between Lopez and Ray appears to have been resolved after lengthy discussions, at which other members of the CCIP acted as mediators, in early August.
- Although en earlier date was desired, the group was unable to agree on a date. Pay eaid that a JURE rounion, which could not be postponed, was scheduled to be held during the third week of Hovember. December was not considered because of the holidays, and, following that, January is spent paying all of the Christmas bills."
- 5. All members of the CCEP will be eligible to attend the congress. A representative of each of the two branches will determine who will be invited from areas where there are no CCEP chapters. CONFIDENTIAL

- 6. Both the CCEP and the splinter proup which publishes fevolucion have discussed creating the PRC. The sain difference appears to be in the timing. The CCEP feels that it would be presented to attempt to form a political party at this time, while the fevolucion group, considered redical by the CCEP, fevore forming the party immediately. (Cf. UFG-8436, UFC-8443, and UFG-8477)
- 7. UTG-8976 incorroutly identified hunes as Enrique Hunes Gomes, with the comment that he sight be identical with a person by the same name who was formerly associated with the Second Hational Front of the Escantray (SFHI).

Available information indicates that Enrique Numes Alvares was also formerly associated with the STHE. By early 1966 be was living in Puerto Rico and was associated with JURE.

- T. Rabala way be identical to Pelix Zabala Mas who was a member of the SPME-Alpha-16 in Puerto Rico, and supported Vectora's faction of that group.
- 9. Veciana is probably Antonio Veciana Blanch, a former leader of Alpha-66.
- 10. Quades may be identical to Emilio Guede who was reported to be a member of the Emile Delegation of JURE in July 1965. He was believed to be identical with Emilio Guede Fernandes. (Cf. UPA-7471)
