- 1. On 7 August 1961 AMPLINK-1 debricted the following Cuban refugues at the ODURGE Page: Albor MUIZ Salazar, Angel Jorge NORREGIAS y Haria, Arturo MORALES y Casias, and Jenaro 1. HERMIDA y Rodriguez, who strived in Florida aboard the CONCHA from Varaders, Matanzas Province.
- 2. Albor. RUIZ Salazar, aka "Raul", was horn in Cardenas, Maranzas frovince, on 27 November 1940. He is unmarried and lives at Viraderomeach, Matanzas Province. He is a graduate of the Methodist school, in croyresiva, in Cardenas, and was also a first-year law student at the iniversity of Habana. He is currently the provincial leader of the Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil (DHE) for Hatanzas.
