1. PRESS ARTICLE DATE LINED MEXICO 21 JULY BY BERT QUIDT, HERALD TRIBUNE NEWS SERVICE, REPORTS CUBAN EXILES NOW MAKING MAJOR EFFORT UNIFY FORCES FOR A CO-SPONSORED DRIVE AGAINST CASTRO REGIME. ARTICLE CLAIMS "EXILE SOURCES IN MEXICO CITY" SAY CHANGE IN CUBAN EXILE ATTITUDE ACCCOMPANIED BY CHANGE IN U.S. GOVERNMENT TACTICS. WASHINGTON "AT LEAST TACITLY" HELPING "LESS CONSERVATIVE EXILE GROUPS", INCLUDING MANOLO RAY. AS CONSEQUENCE, CRC HAS BEEN LOSING INFLUENCE.

2. REQUEST MEXI VIEWS ON RELIABILITY JOURNALIST QUIDT AND IF FEASIBLE IDENTIFY SOURCES HIS ARTICLE. FMI ARTICLE AND OTHERS SIMILAR TO IT HAVE BEEN PART OF WELL PLANNED AND COORDINATED PUBLIC RELATIONS CAMPAIGN TO BUILD UP RAY AS LEADER EXILE COMMUNITY AND POST-CASTRO CUBA.
