

said he had recently returned from a ten day visit to Mexico City and had visited with Foreign Minister Manuel Tello. Tello said that Mexico will be in a very difficult position at the coming OAS meeting. That although Mexico could take a strong stand against Cuba it will not do so. That Mexico would only go so far as to say that solidarity in the Western Hamisphere is essential that the countries in Latin America should be aware of the Communist dangers; that intervention to a serious danger and that the OAS take whatever action it can when necessary in order to avoid a country Isaid he then told Tello 05 from intervening in the affairs of another. that Caba could not be overlooked as it was a serious problem. Tello countered by saying that the Cuban situation and Dominican question should not be confused in the over-all panorams. Further, that the business interests of the United States in Cuba were not a proper matter of discussion at the UAS but that this problem should be presented before the International Court at The Hague as the OAS is not set up to handle such problems. Icllo said that it would be a mistake for the United States to refer to the Caracas resolution on Communism in the O.S. Telle said that the situation in Mexico has changed so much recently that he himself is in danger because he is considered as too much of a middle-of the-roader, and is looking for an assignment as an Ambassador aid that his impressions of 05 abroad so be can leave the country. Mexico on this trip were that in the last forty-five days Lopez Mateos has lost considerable ground and that General Lazaro Cardenas is getting stronger and if the trend continues, Lazaro Cardenas, will in a short time, emerge as the strong man in Mexico.

said that Argentine Ambassador to the United States del Carril told him previous to leaving for San Francisco that Argentina is watching Cuba only in as much as the Cuban situation affects Argentina because of the presence in Cuba of certain well known Ferunistas and also the Guevara. Let Carril added that the general over-all Cuban problem is viewed by Argentina with the name coolness which the United States deals with the problem of Amarctica.
