GOLITSIN defected during nource in period of cervice with the X.G.B. Source heard about his from various X.O.B. officers but never not his and knew of him only by this name. *Irian TEPLIANOTA however also know of GOLITSIN on KUROV. She heard his story when she visited her parents in Finland and, while there, she met GOLITSIN's wife who called on her nother.

- 2. With regard to COLITSYN's defection, source said he had been told in London by both Konstantin Ivanovich 7010V had of K.G.A. Ignach 2 (Counter-intelligence) there, and Saircy Kikhaylovich COLUBEY, the K.G.B. officer responsible for the S.K., that GOLITSYN, whose job in Finland source described as "Breach 2 or something", had alreaded violently with his Resident in Bolsinki. He wrote a number of official and private letters to Rescow asking that either he or the Resident be transferred. Headquarters refueded to agree this, and when he visited Rescow threatened that if he failed to get on with the Resident he would be in danger of lesing his job. This was too such for GOLITSYN, so he defeated. Source edded that this reason for GOLITSYN's defection was convincing, and that he had noter heard any rumour that it was not germine.
- 3. Source gave the following information about the measures taken by the K.G.B. as the result of GOLIVSYN's defections
 - (a) He had been sentenced to death; this was stated in an article in "The Chekist" which appeared some time after 1964. The K.C.B. would try to kill him as soon as they could find him.
 - (b) Within six weeks of GOLUBEY's arrival in London on 12.6.71. he told course that he had received a telegram from Herdquarters ordering him to concentrate on obtaining information about GOLUTSTN, (to whom the K.G.B. had given the abunive nickname UNOD), because according to their information GOLUTSTN had visited England several times, and while they had now cotablished "the place of residence" they had no approach to him. Hoseow required detailed information about where he was living habits and activities. From the wording of this telegram source deduced that GOLUTSTN was not resident in England, and that the object of this order was to remind GOLUBEY of a standing instruction that the highest priority was to be given to obtaining information about him.
