1. Here is a sequel to the information given in the reference. On Mednosday morning, I December, about 0350 hours, VILINE/s salled Rooding at Proding's home and said that he would like to use us on an unrest matter. We met him helf as bour later, and he told us the following story. Grigorly Ye COLID had reported to VALINA/1 that a western agent 07 had been arrested in the Coviet Union near Imatrs, but on the Poviet side of the border. GOLIS had said that the egent had been recruited in Switzerland and dispatched across the border on 18 May of this year. The egent had come to Relatinki on 17 May and had been met by a man described as between 55 and 58 years old, about 180 cm. tall; the man described as between 55 and 58 years old, about 180 cm. tall; the man smoked a pipe, epoke good Reglish and passable Finnish. This man had driven the agent to the Finnish border in a Dodge automobile, bearing the license plate EF-158, on the 18th of May.

- 2. When VALIMA/8 began the investigation of this report, he found that the Dodge our was owned by VADAW/1 a firm and thought therefore that we might be involved. Since he wanted to vern us, he took it won himself to call Roodine to tip Roodine off in case it might be necessary to get the driver of the car out of the country before the investigation closed Oin around him. Roodine thanks of A.DK/b for his tip and said he would shook into the matter to find or if there was any substance to it. Roodine promised to call VALTEK/E by 1630 hours that afternoon.
- 3. Accordingly, we checked with our three military staches offices with negative results and then decided to go to VIPP// himself to find out if he had even loaned his car for any such trips or was somehow involved indirectly. The answer with him was also negative, and it now appears likely that this whole story is a provocation, concected by the Soviets and set afoot through COUTS to serve as a counter-balance to recent revelations of Soviet espionage in Finland. (See the Endrsey's Joint Weeks for 11 December 1959.) It is interesting that the Communist newspaper Kensen Putiest carried an editorial on the 10th of Penerber accusing the Security Folice of not investigating cases of western espionage. The editorial makes pointed reference to a trip made by the assistant American neval attache last summer, which was written up in the Communist press and reported at the time to Tashington via Yabasey channels. A copy of the Lansan Untiest editorial is attached.
