1. As a fellow-up to Reference A, walch briefly mentioned the Soviet attempts at "cultural cultivation" of various young Firmish foreign Office personnel, we would like to comment on similar actions regarding younger menters of the Mestern Divionatic and Consular Corps in Helsing. Escently, within about the last two months, Soviet Exhausy officials here, particularly Crimoriy Te. CCUM' and V. F. CHILIOVSKI+, have been making an effortm to invite younger members of the Western embassies to lunch or to view Sovist movies playing at local movie houses. For instance, GCLUP has invited howard B. Singleton of the Caratian Legation to lunch with him and later he was seen having lunch with Aydin Yegen of the Turkish Eatassy. There was also another Saviet, Makeyeve, at these two luncheons acting as interpretere (We believe this is Mikolay Makeyev, the TRED representative here.) (Coineidentally, Costille was just interrupted by a phone call from Golub inviting a him to lunch today.) Chalkovski has invited ajeli Colding of the Borwsgian Exhausy, Willes koomlorp of the Dutch Embassy and Herbert Lesser of the Heat German Legation to a showing of the Soviet film "The Idiet." Golub had invited Costille to the same showing but Costille was unable to go. At a later lunch Colub maked Costile to be sure he saw "The Idiot" so the next time they had lunch they could discuss it. It is interesting to note that all of the above westerners are between the ages of 28-33 and all bachelors. The engagements are strictly non-political and usually cultural tomics are discussed. The general ordrion is that both of the Soviets, Golub and Chalkovaid, are very sociable and friendly. They pick up allekecks and make sure that their guest is well wined and dired.

- 2. We are not certain of the value of all this information but felt it was worth reporting as this sultural courting of the younger Western Embasey people seems to have definitely increased in the last two months and has been a favorite topic of discussion at recent Western Embassy functions.
- 3. In this same context, we are attaching a copy of Embassy Despatch 623 conserving <u>Computer Emphasis on Youth Activities in Pinland</u>, which also discusses the Soviet Embassy's courting of various Firmish youth organisations. Since the Despatch also discusses the Vienna Touth Pestival, it may be of interest to the LCOUTECARD dask.
