Addendus to the Study on the Mirectorio Revolucionario Iberico de Liberacion (Iberian Asvolutionary Directorate of Liberation)-DELL

I. GETTAL PERSONALI ME

According to Juan FIFTAL, the moving spirit behind the Spanish smarchists in France, the Fil (Federation of Iberian Americans) is not collaborating with either the Communists or the DELL.

II. CUIA/BELDIUM/DRIL BLATI. BELTI

A 28 July 1960 report stated that the <u>Branish-Belgian Franciship Society</u> in Relgion receives financial aid from Humberto Rodrigues 19889, Cuban Rebassy in Medrid.

The Fresident of the Society is Felix FERMANDEZ Santistoban, and its Secretary is Eduardo TELL Nobet.

It is interesting to note here that Abderraman NULLY Nove requested, in a latter to "Cho" GUEVARA, financial aid from the Cuban Government and a release of exile DRIL funds ever which General BAYD had control. As a follow-up to this letter Eloy GUYLIPHEZ Monoyo went to Lieve, Belgium, to make a first-hand estimate of DRIL leadership, capabilities, and potential, preliminary to the unfreezing of any funds in the Hational Bank of Cuba. Later as a result of some interregations of DRIL members apprehended in Belgium, it was bearned that Fidel CASTED has agreed to release large amounts of Spanish funds blocked in Cuba to support the DRIL with the provision that CASTED can be assured that the nature of this organisation is purely revolutionary and is dedicated to the overthrow of the France Regime.

III. APRICA/DRIL RELATIONSHIP

Maximo PEMA and Mavier LASTRA, both IRIL members, have taken the initiative along with several Belgians apapathetic to the Spanish cause, of organizing a group called Liero-Lauagna. A meeting of this organization was held in the Hotel Central, Liego, Belgium, on 2 deptember 1960. Admission was by invitation only, and several members of the CTRI (Comits Solge pour la Paix en Algaria, Belgian Committee for Feace in Algeria) were prepare.

17. PROMINCIPLES

1. Justo Paraiel Con N. A. Chinesi

Subject, a Cutan, is the father of Juan Manuel Chill's Veres, a Cuban imbassy employee in Madrid. Subject is an attache at the Cuban imbassy, Madrid, and is also a member of the Cuban organization, Milk (Departmento de Investigaciones del Ejercito Revolucionarto). His principal mission in Spain is to give aid to the CRIL.

2. Jose Antonio Carriella Granges

BOBS 25 December 1925 at Pasajes de San Fedro. Subject was arrested by the Belgian police on 6 August 1960 in liege, Belgium, as a member of the DBIL. As of 19 August 1960, he was still being detained by the police. This brother, Felix DESIRECT Grange, born 12 July 1930 at Pasajes do San Pedro, was likewise appreadended. There have been as further details on Felix. He, herever, carried on his person a list of names and addresses of correspondents in various countries which the Pelgian police confiscated.

J. Arturo O. NZALEZ into Llector

DOB: 25 key 1926 in Issa de Langreo, Oviedo, Brain. Subject prepared two suitcase bombs which were sent by rail on the Madrid-Barcelons train, and which exploded on the mail car on 27 June 1960. He, then, is believed to have fied to France or Relgium. After his arrest by the Belgian police, along with other DAIL members, on 6 August 1960, he was interrogated and reportedly put across the Datch border by the Belgians on 18 August 1960; however, there has been no evidence that he ever entered Relland.

h. Floy GUTISESIZ Bengros

Subject was been in Spain and Curing the Cuban Havolution fought in the Escanbray Sountains. As a DRIL leader from Cuba, Jubject, on 16 July 1960, was lodged at the Cuban Embasy in Eadrid. At that time, he was an route to Furis,

France. His trip to the European continent was connected with Iffi matters. In Liege, Belgium, he was arrested on 6 August 1760, and interrogated. He was then purportedly expelled from Delgium as of 17 August and returned to Cuba. A later report, however, stated that he departed by plane for Paris on 12 August 1960.

5. Hayes MANIN Forost

Subject has been identified as the institutor of the bombings which took place in San Sebastian, Spain, in late June or early July, 1960. The stated that further acts of terrurism were to be consisted in late July. From mid-July to early August, he was in Toulouse, Prence. On 6 August 1960, MARIH was apprehended along with other DRIL members by the Salgian police in Liege, Belgium. He was searched, questioned, and reportedly sent across the Butch border on 18 August 1960. There has been, however, no evidence that acither he nor his compatriot, Arture GONZALEZ Mata Liedo, are currently in Holland, or in fact over entered the Dutch territory.

6. Maximo PERA Comsales:

Liege, Belgium, and is a member of AREL (Agrupacion Republicana Espanola de Liega), an anti-Franco group which is deminsted by Communists and Recialists. According to a Dubject is an architect by profession and is in charge of the political and diplomatic matters for the DELL; but he has been identified by others as the accountant and financial manager of the DELL in Mage.

7. Marmel Abderraran MUL Y Hore, ava Sanuel Belies

PCB: 73 Cotober 1923 in Barcelona, Spain. Subject solicited financial aid
from Cubs and other Latin American countries, specifically, Argentina and Venesuels,
for continued CRIL terrorist activity in Spain in a letter to "Che" GUEYARA, head
of the Cubsu Mational Bank. He also requested that G. MYARA or Raul CASTRL contact
General Alberto Bayo Giraud in an effort to entice him into graing support to the

THIS as a RCE leader. He likewise claimed that the two fortiguese, Fernands

the DHIS and to consider Angola to be "another easy front". Dos DATES is

reportedly organizing a shipment of Eugoslav area to go to Fortuguese Africa

from Tangler. ROWS was one of the arrestess of the Beigian police in August 1960.

As of 19 August he was still being detailed by the police.

8. Rainel Paris XX-Ruigi

DUBL 29 October 1920 in Madrid, Spain. He is a citizen of Venezuela. He was exceeded by the Balgian police in Lingua as a DRIL member in early August 1960 and as of 19 August was still being detained by the police. When he was scarched and interrogeted, the following was found to be in his possessions

- (1) A sabotage manual prepared by Ceneral Alberto BATO
- (2) A delayed action incendiary device
- (3) Miscellaneous correspondence
- (5) Financial records and other documents
