1. Reference is made to this office's CSCI-3/766,642, dated 9 August 1961, concerning the above Subject.

- 2. We have recently learned that KANTOR has returned to Copenhagen, Desmark from a trip to Yugoelevia, and that he plane to depart for New York in early September. He has recently been in daily contact with one William STEINSCITH, an American citizen born about 193), who is currently living in Fermark without a recidence permit. We have been advised by a usually reliable source that STRINGHITH has maintained a clandestine contact with a Cuben official in Copenhagen, and that he has sold pro-CASTRO articles to the local Danish press. We have also been advised that KANTOR recently obtained a check for \$1000, estensibly from his father, to pay for his fare back to the United States.
- 3. We will forward to you any additional information we may receive in this matter. It is suggested, in the meantime, that it may be in order to assertain, if possible, whether KAMCR's father has in fast recently acquired the abovementioned sum and forwarded it to the Subject.
