1. In the reference, we listed the members of the delegation from [redacted] to the annual meeting of the [redacted] in Washington in 1971. We understand that pretty much the same party will attend this year, probably with the addition of Frank Loretta, head of Dupont of Mexico. [redacted] this year. (6-3)

2. Again, I would like to ask you to give them a luncheon meeting as you did last year. That was a very successful afternoon. The only critical comment I had from [redacted] Mr. [redacted] was that one was confined to talking to the persons next to him, rather than there being general conversation. He did not seem to consider this important but I pass it on to you in case you want to consider some different format for the get-together.
