SUBJECT: Response to Memo on "Council for Latin America".

The activities of V-1 touch upon four organizations listed below. There are no other activities as they may concern organizations listed on the CI memo. (attached).

L-1
currently budgeted at \$60,000 annually, supports in part this organization, which also receives funds (some \$950,000 yearly) from [redacted] fund with headquarters in Aschaffenburg, Germany. The objective of this effort is to help establish model or prototype agrarian organizations designed to alleviate and hopefully to avenge the social and economic ills of the German economy.

2.
The executive director of this organization was formerly associated with the LIHEPP project, but he is no longer an active member of this project which is funded at the current rate of \$4,000 annually and supports LIHEPP-1, the Station's only agent with access to Rightist political organizations.

3. The director of this organization (LISLENE-J) is no longer an active NOFACT agent. The LINCH project was terminated in 1965 and had been funded at an annual rate of some \$65,000. The project supported a mass media propaganda effort directed at the middle and lower classes of Mexico and sponsored by a front group of conservative Mexican businessmen.

4. The vice president of this organization is a current Station asset, LHMW-1. No money is provided from KOFAC sources to this organization, although LHMW-1 receives monthly \$300.00. The duties of this agent do not directly relate to his
