SUBJECT: Activities of the Movimiento Recuperacion Revolucionaria (MRR), Anti-CASTRO Organization

COMMENTS:

1. Source does not remember names easily, and some of the names mentioned in this report may be incomplete. While Source was extremely open and co-operative in describing most details of the MRR, he refused to identify the MRR member within Cuban Army. Intelligence on the grounds that the information was too sensitive.
2. Regarding information requested in DIR-14969, Source reported that two radio stations are being established, one in Mexico and one in Cuba. The MRR manifesto is still pending and must be read by Source before it circulates in Cuba. The MRR has circulated the following anti-CASTRO materials:
 - (a) The resignation letter of Manuel Francisco ANTILLER Buesa;
 - (b) A chapter of ANTILLER's book (the chapter is entitled "Unforgettable Meeting")
 - (c) A second letter from ANTILLER in reply to accusations made on television by Fidel CASTRO;
 - (d) Two pamphlets, entitled PATIESTA Father of Communism, by Oscar SNEVARIAN, and ANTI Communist.
3. Regarding Para. 6, Source reported that Frank BERNARDINO met, on the plane from Habana to Mexico, a member of the British Embassy in Mexico City who invited him, and through him, Source to talk with him at the British Embassy.



1. The main centers of activity of the Movimiento Recuperacion Revolucionaria (MRR, co-ordinated anti-CASIO movement)¹ within Cuba are in the provinces of Habana, Pinar del Rio, Camaguey, and Oriente. The MRR has the following leaders in Cuba:



- national Territorial co-ordinator
 - general co-ordinator
 - treasurer
 - director of propaganda
 - chief of Oriente Province
 - chief of Malaya Province
 - chief military co-ordinator
 - chief of action
 - secretary of university affairs
 - chief, municipality

The MGR is also in touch with members of the Revolutionary Government of Cuba, including a member of Cuban Army Intelligence (d-2). The wife of Dr. Martiniano Munoz, May Rivero, former Minister of Public Education; former head of the 26th of July Movement in Havana when it was a clandestine organization, also are in touch with the MGR. Military leaders of the Revolutionary Government in Oriente, Santa Clara, and Pinar del Rio provinces are being contacted by the MGR, and it is making special efforts to recruit Major [redacted]

3. In addition to the integrated groups of the MGR, both inside and outside of Cuba, the MGR has relations and is endeavoring to obtain closer alliances, co-operation, or co-partition with the following: Manuel Antonio VATTICA and his followers within the Partido Autentico Abstencionista; leaders of the "MART" group; and the "27th of March" group of Camaguey province. The organization is also in touch with some former BATTISTA officers, such as Major AGUERA and Manuel VILLARIA Martinez, and with [redacted] 06
4. The MGR needs: 1) a base where it can give military training to young people who lack military experience; 2) instructors to give the military training; and 3) equipment, including armaments and planes. Many Cubans, both in Cuba and abroad, have offered financial assistance to the MGR; however, the money will not be forthcoming until a base is established in Cuba from which the MGR can start working.
5. José CÁCERES, Cuban now in Mexico, has been reported to the MGR as an informer for Field CUSTODIO [redacted] 5-6440
6. Frank MECALDO, one of the AD members who participated in the Bahia flotilla laying episode directed against Amatista (Vinales), is now in Mexico City. He said that many of those who participated in the event are in hiding and will have to leave Cuba. MECALDO was discharged from his job in a bank for his part in the incident.

2. VATTICA has great possibilities of becoming the candidate for president of the MGR.
3. This group is called either the "MGR" or "MART".
4. The MGR excludes all well-known BATTISTA officials, both civilian and military men; however, it has distant relatives of both civilian and military associated with the BATTISTA régime, who are efforts made to use them in minor roles within the MGR.
