- a. Film 294 photo 1 Mexican lawyer who does errands for
Film 293 photo 23 members of the Cuban Embassy

This person entered the Cuban Embassy in a Cadillac car with license plates 7-14-73 which in 1963 were registered to Aurelio MUÑOZ Soileiro, Matrices de Tlacubaya No. 39, Station files contain a reference to one Aurelio MUÑOZ who is contributor to the PCM.

- b. Film 273 photos 19 & 20 diplomatic couriers

The subject of phot. 20 is a courier named Augustin YASSELLS Gonzalez who transits Mexico about every other month. 24

- c. Film 279 photo 9 Jorge LAIN

Jorge LAIN departed Mexico PCM on 18 May 1964. [redacted] indicated his departure may have been sudden and unexpected.

d. Film 256 photo 8 Felipe LLAUDI

LLAUDI was seen entering the Cuban Embassy in the company of Rogelio RODRIGUEZ Lopez on this date.

e. Film 183 photo 1 Carlos RELOVA
Film 181 photo 27

Carlos RELOVA was observed leaving the Cuban Embassy on 26 June 1963 at 0:20 which possibly implies that he was staying at the Embassy. A check of the Cuban travel run for 1963 shows no record of RELOVA's travel to Mexico.

f. Film 264 photo 24 Alfonso PEREZ Leon - Cuban courier

Alfonso PEREZ Leon transits Mexico about every other month. He usually goes to Santiago, Chile, but in August made a trip to Tokyo.
