SUBJECT : La Revolution Africaine - Algerian Weekly Magazine

1. This office has recently received information that La Revolution Africaine, the Algerian magazine referred to in Reference, appeared for the first time in Algiers on February 2, 1963. Editors of the magazine are Jacques VIEGES, a known Communist, and Zohra DAIF, wife of the Vice Premier of Algeria Rabah BITAT. SINE, a well-known French leftist cartoonist does the political cartoons for the magazine. The magazine claims to have offices in New York City, Paris, London, Dar-es-Salaam, Havana and Lausanne. The address for the New York City office of the magazine is 244 East 66th Street.
2. This office would appreciate any information the Bureau can provide on both the activities and employees of the New York office of the magazine.
