A.M. "MOTEL SITUATION"

Summary of Visit to: Tegucigalpa, Honduras  
 10 days (from 10/26 to 11/05)  
 4000 miles by air  
 Mixed tour & business.

1. Subject stated he checked in at Hotel Alba, 10/26, and remained in connection with [redacted] (name unknown) on 10/26, 1968, in Tegucigalpa, La. Villas. His parole and probation were suspended during his stay on the subject. He is a member of the Executive group of United Free Latin America-SAC. He was arrested on 10 April 1968 and released 1 June 1968. He spent all this time in the Central Party HQ together with the following 12 revolutionaries: Pedro A. Bradley and his wife, both members of Villalobos University, UNA Obra, director of the Faculty of Law, Dr. Hugo Mazzoni, Ambassador, and another unidentified US national. The above mentioned individuals were still in La. Villas when subject left.
2. Subject stated that one George Alonso Chiriboga, a radio operator who entered clandestinely into Cuba from the US to assist the underground, turned up to the G.A. Alonso informed USSR -1 of the clandestine operations; our operation was named Silver and the other VEGA.
3. Subject stated that he is most anxious to continue contact with representatives of US agencies in order to render a full report of the conditions of some of the emergency groups in Cuba. Subject is known to English and French and is personally acquainted with our Cuban and Belgian Ambassadors in Moscow. He also wants to contact someone which is the code name of a liaison agent for the underground in the US.
4. Subject was extremely nervous and excited and requested that he be allowed to rest for a few days before subject is reinterviewed.
