Dum Doctor Macoo!

a 33 year old Cuban male refugee was first with our clinic on October 14, 1965 with the history of having anosphalitis at the age of 3, having seizures at the age of 12, being treated with medication, doing well until 1958 when he was braten by the Batista police. From that time on he had 4 or 5 recipros a month, fought in the Bay of Pigs, escaped from Cuba, and was treated in the United States at Mercy Hospital.

This seizures continued and in 1964 removal of a focal opileptic focus from his Right Corobral Homisphere was done in Kemphis. Since that time has been on Dilantin, Fhenobarbital, and Kysoline, to took medications irregularly and had frequent seizures. Since that time has been repeatedly seen in clinic, and we have tried to bring his seizures under control by getting him to take his medication regularly. At the present time we are still trying to regulate his medication. He has 2 to 3 seizures per month.
