## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Ambassador Carrillo's Contact with Yenezuelan Returning from Moscow

Carrera, Cuban Ambassador to France, missed a dinner engagement with AnwhiP-1. On 2 February Carrillo excused himself for not being able to keep the date explaining he was held up handling an emergency matter for a Venexuelan who arrived in Paris from Moscow. Ambell-1 got the impression Carrillo had to either pick up or deliver the Venexuelan to a railroad station and that part of the problem was that the Venexuelan's papers or documents were not in order. Carrillo also stated it was a sensitive matter as he had taken another person who was armed with him. AmwhiP-1 was requested to attempt to establish the identity of the Venezuelan and the purpose and reason for his travel.
