WINSTON SCOTT HEAD OF CIA OFFICE HERE, JUST ADVISED RECEIPT OF CABLE FROM HIS HEADQUARTERS FURNISHING INFO RE POLYGRAPH OPERATOR. [SCOTT] STATED HIS CABLE FURNISHED DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS TO EFFECT CUSTODY OF (ALVARADO) SHOULD BE OBTAINED FROM MEXICANS, THAT (ALVARADO) SHOULD BE FED AND GIVEN A CHANCE TO REST AND THAT INTERVIEW SHOULD BE CONDUCTED ONLY IN PRESENCE OF POLYGRAPH OPERATOR AND THE WRITER. [SCOTT] SAID HIS CABLE INDICATED THAT THIS SHOULD BE DONE BECAUSE IT MIGHT BE NECESSARY FOR WRITER TO TRAVEL TO WASHINGTON TO REPORT ON RESULTS OF INTERVIEW.

IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING CALL FROM MR. SULLIVAN THIS OFFICE TOOK
INITIAL STEPS TO STOP DEPORTATION OF (ALVARADO) TO NICARAGUA WHICH
WAS SCHEDULED FOR 8 AM TOMORROW. SINCE SCOTT ORIGINALLY HANDLED
TURNING OVER TO MEXICANS OF (ALVARADO) WHO WAS UNDER CIA CONTROL,
HE TONIGHT IS TAKING UP MATTER OF POLYGRAPH TEST OF (ALVARADO) WITH
LINUS ECHEVERRIA ACTING MINISTER OF GOBERNACION, TO ASCERTAIN
WHETHER MEXICANS WILLING TO RELEASE (ALVARADO) FOR TEST. POSSIBILITY
ALWAYS EXISTS THAT MEX CANS MAY FEEL THEIR NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY
BEING INVADED AND THEY MAY INSIST ON HAVING ONE OR MORE OBSERVERS
PRESENT DURING TEST.
