The procession, which started again today, lasted yesterday and the day before yesterday from the early hours of the morning until around midnight.

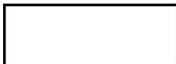
Radio, television, and the press gave lengthy comments on the late president, reporting his biography and stressing his intellectual qualities, poise, and courage, not hiding the concern over the grave loss. 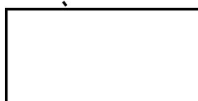
