Dear Mr Redfern

This is in response to your correspondence of 3 Feb 94 regarding whether or not the so-called "Roswell Incident" could possibly be explained by the theory that this was a test US missile crash that may have had rhesus monkeys as passengers (and hence, that the bodies of such primates were subsequently mistaken as "aliens"). Although I have seen similar speculation in the popular press as a possible alternative explanation of this incident, I have never seen any US Government documents, classified or not, to indicate that this might be so.

As you know, the "Roswell Incident" was a seminal event in UFO believers' history and it is vitally important to believers that this incident be attributed to a crashed "flying saucer" (or "flying disc" as they were called in those days); and that alien bodies were recovered from the "spacecraft". Simply put, if that explanation is not true and there is any other explanation (such as the one put forth in your letter) then much of what has been published subsequently regarding UFO's would automatically be proven spurious (the so-called "MJ-12 papers" are an obvious example). Other possible explanations, such as the crashed experimental aircraft or downed Japanese Fugo balloon theories would have the same result. Likewise, new confirmation of the historically stated explanation (downed balloon) would further detract from many subsequent UFO claims, which have flowed from the "Roswell Incident."

Coincidentally, with the recent renewal of interest in the "Roswell Incident" within UFO circles, there has been concurrent official US government interest generated by a Congressman from New Mexico. As a result, the General Accounting Office (GAO), the investigative arm of Congress, will be inquiring into how such reports were previously handled, with an apparent focus on the "Roswell Incident". This inquiry is being initiated as this is written. Certainly your crashed rocket theory seems a reasonable scenario to explore for possible records as are the other theories mentioned. I assume GAO will consider them all.

Part of the frustration in trying to explain such incidents well after the fact is the average citizen's lack of knowledge of informational and archival systems. Specifically, most people do not realize the type or volume of information available in US archives. More importantly, they do not realize the type or amount of data <u>not</u> available. Consequently, when information is not available it is usually attributed to malevolent motivations or sinister "cover-ups." When it is available but doesn't correlate with the information seeker's theory, then it is often characterized as having been altered or labeled as disinformation. This is truly a "no-win" situation for those of us in government. We are, in effect, either bunglers or conspirators.

Since you have taken your valuable time to write to me in my official capacity, you should be aware of the fact that any response from me will be viewed as highly suspect from some persons within the UFO community. In fact, I am routinely vilified by a number of US UFO researchers (and at least one of your countrymen) as one of the arch co-conspirators preventing the public from learning the "real truth" about UFO's. The actual truth is that there is no grand conspiracy and I would very much like to devote full time to my real job of protecting currently classified national defense information.

I thank you for your correspondence and recommend that you await the GAO report of this matter. Since the GAO is not part of the US military, perhaps its findings will be viewed in a different light.



Reference is made to a memorandum to Mr. Harbo from Mr. Baughman rele. Room on the above-cartioned matter, dated September 3, 1947. The reference memorandum indicates that the instrument has been examined by the Laboratory and the Laboratory had contacted a Mrs. Whedon of the Army Engineers and she indicated that the instrument had been used by the Air Forces on tests which were classified as "Top Secret."

The memorandum indicates that Special Agent S. W. Reynolds of the Liaison Section contacted the Intelligence Division of the Air Forces and was advised that Mrs. Whodon alluded that the instrument was used in "Operation Mogul." The instrument was loaned to the Intelligence Division of the Air Forces who in turn forwarded it to Wright Field. The report was received from Wright Field indicating the instrument had no connection with "Operation Mogul" or any other operation at Wright Field. It was classified as a hoar in viow of the apparent discrepancy between information developed from Mrs. The don and information received from Intelligence Division of the Air Forces that the Bureau might wish to pursue this matter further.

Mr. Zimmers of the Technical Laboratory advised Mr. Reynolds of the Liaison Section that Mrs. Wheden had told him that a Major Hopkins handled the Liaison in Washington for the tests in which this instrument was used. Meutenant Colonel George Garrett of the Intelligence Division of the Air Forces advised Special Agent Reynolds that he contacted Major Hopkins. He advised that Major Hopkins has had a great deal of experience in radio and along technical lines. Major Hopkins advised Colonel Garrett that the instrument could not have been used in the "Operation Mogul." Hopkins indicated that from the pictures and particles recovered, it appeared to him to be a part or portions of an old-type radio loud speaker.

In view of the information received from Major Hopkins, Colonel Gaffett stated that he was at a loss as to how to explain the actions of Mrs. Whedon other then to say that she perhaps cave a false impression as to her knowledge of the instrument and the "Operation Mogol." Garrett pointed out that in view of the report received from Wright Field, together with the statement made by Major Hopkins, he felt that there was sufficient evidence that this instrument was not used in any the partment classified project and that in all probability it was just a hoax.



Thank you for your letter concerning rumors involving objects of an extra terrestrial nature that may be kept in the "Blue Room" at Wright-Patterson A.F.B.

Quite frankly, with respect to this subject, about which I am not personally familiar, I must defer to the position of Senator Goldwater, Chairman of the Senate Intelligence Committee, when he writes that "this thing has gotten so highly classified...it is just impossible to get anything on it."





The subject named above is cited as authority for a highly fanciful book entitled. Behind the Flying Saucers, written by one Frank Scully and published by Holt in 1950. The gist of the book is that the so-called flying saucers are really manifestations of secret and sinister scientific research by the government.

Newton's arrest record, as shown by your files, is familiar to us. He is the owner of the Newton Oil Company, a small but active oil producing organization with offices at 315 Franklin Street, Denver, Colorado. He describes himself as a graduate of Yale, which appears to be true and as a geophysicist engaged in secret governmental research.

He is apparently wealthy, or at least possessed of sufficient temporary means to live in luxury and dress expensively. His home is at 1929 Whitley Street, Hollywood, but all messages to him, or appointments with him, must be made through the Hollywood Knickerbocker Hotel.

We are writing you because stated that a complete investigation of Newton has been made by your Bureau. Presumably this investigation has confirmed his cryptic allusions to his being engaged in governmental research of a secret nature.

Other circumstances coming to our attention in the light of his criminal record indicate to us that Newton is engaged in the perpetration of a hoax or swindle of large



SUBJECT

PROCESSING REPORTS OF SIGHTINGS OF SPACE VEHICLE FRAGMENTS

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Instruction is to establish procedures for handling reports of sightings of objects such as fragments or component parts of space vehicles known or alleged by an observer to have impacted upon the earth's surface as a result of safety destruct action, failure in flight, or reentry into the earth's atmosphere. Included are reports of sightings of objects not related to space vehicles.

2. APPLICABILITY

This Instruction is applicable to all organizational elements of the John F. Kennedy Space Center, NASA (KSC) and to NASA/KSC contractors as expressed in the terms of their contracts.

3. POLICY

It is KSC policy to respond to reported sightings of space vehicle fragments and unidentified flying chiects as promptly as possible. All KSC personnel and activities will cooperate to ensure that pertinent information relative to such sightings is received and processed as set forth in this Instruction.

. DEFINITIONS

space Vehicle Fragment: A fragment or component part of a space vehicle that has impacted upon the surface of the earth or washed up on a beach conceivably as a result of safety destruct actions, failure in flight, or reentry into the earth's atmosphere.

b. Unidertified Flying Object: An unidentified object observed in the atmosphere.

PROCEDURES FOR HANDLING REPORTS OF SIGHTINGS

- a. KSC telephone operators will refer all telephone calls coming into the KSC switchboard from persons reporting sightings, as defined herein, to the KSC Scheduling Branch, Test Support Management Office, telephone 857-3013.
- Persons other than telephone operators receiving initial reports of sightings will, if possible, transfer the call to the KSC Scheduling Branch. If the call cannot be transferred, the following information should be obtained from the caller and immediately transmitted to the KSC Scheduling Branch:
 - > (1) Name, address, and telephone number of the observer and any other information needed to establish the identity of the observer for possible immediate follow-up contact.
 - > (2) Description of the object sighted, i.e., shape, size, color, etc.
 - >(3) Location of the object: state, city, etc.
- NOTE: Under no circumstances will the origin of the object be discussed with the observer or person making the call.
 - c. The KSC Scheduling Branch, in response to a report of a sighting, will:
 - > (1) Contact military bases nearest the sighting to enlist their aid in determining the validity of the sighting.
 - >(2) Contact the KSC Security Office who will in turn contact municipal and State police nearest the sighting to enlist their aid in determining the validity of the sighting.
 - >(3) Consult with the Public Information Branch, Public Affairs Office, on reported sightings that may be of public interest.

- >(4) Refer all inquiries from news media to the Public Information Branch.
- >(5) Consult with the Senior Scientist, KSC, on all sightings reported.
- > (6) Call in unidentified flying object reports to the Patrick
 Air Force Base Command Post, telephone 494-7001.
 - d. All written communications received from persons or activities reporting a sighting will be immediately transmitted to the Senior Scientist, KSC.

RESPONSIBILITIES

. 6.

- a. . Test Support Management Office will be responsible for:
 - Developing and maintaining a capability for receiving, screening, and processing reports of sightings, as defined in paragraph 4, on a 24-hour-day, 7-day-week basis.
 - (2) Ensuring close liaison with the Senior Scientist, KSC, and the Public Affairs Office on matters pertaining to this Instruction.
 - (3) Coordinating with the Senior Scientist, KSC, as soon as possible after a reported sighting to determine the action to be taken.
- b. The ISC Scheduling Branch, Test Support Management Office, will be responsible for maintaining a 24-hour-day, 7-day-week capability for receiving, screening, and processing reports of sightings, in accordance with paragraph 5c.
- . c. The Senior Scientist, KSC, will be responsible for:
 - (1) The overall monitoring of the space vehicle fragment sighting program at ISC.

- (2) Evaluating the screening procedures performed by the KSC Scheduling Branch.
- (3) Conducting or initiating and monitoring the scientific investigation of recovered items.
- (4) Coordinating sightings of space vehicle fragments

- The Communications and Timing Division, Director of Support Operations will be responsible for:
 - (1) Ensuring that KSC telephone operators are properly briefed with regard to their responsibilities as set forth in paragraph 5a.

Office Memorandum · UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT DATE: 7/10/47 SUBJECT FLYING DISKS At request of middler General Coorge F. Schulgen, Chief of the Requirements Intelligence Branch of Army Air Corps Intelligence, Special Agent discussed the above captioned matter with him on July 9, 1947. Coneral Schulgen indicated to that the Air Corps has taken the attitude that every effort must be undertaken in order to run down and ascertain whether or not the flying disks are a fact and, if so, to learn all about them. According to General Schulgen, the Air Corps Intelligence are by 7C utilizing all of their scientists in order to ascertain whether or not such a phenomenon could in fact occur. He stated that this research is being conducted with the thought that the flying objects might be a celestial phenomenon and with the view that they might be a foreign body mechanically devised and controlled. Beneral Schulgen also indicated to that all Air Corps installations have been alerted to run out each reported sighting to obtain all possible data to assist in this research project. In passing, General Schulgen # 74 stated that an Air Corps pilot who believed that he saw one of these objects was thoroughly interrogated by meneral Schulgen and scientists, as well as a paychologist, and the pilot was adament to in his claim that he saw a flying disk. meral similer advised that the possibility exists that the first reported sightings of the so-called flying disks were fallacious and prompted by individuals seeking personal publicity, or were reported for political / reasons. 



Puly Fich says Flying scacers from Venus came to earth by accident. Budy Fick, well known Kansas City auto Cealer stopped in Denver I weeks ago while returning from Ogden, Utah. 

SIGHTINGS OF UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

ADDITIONAL WITNESSES TO PREVIOUS SIGHTINGS-IN SWEDEN -- Stockholm, Svenska Dagbladet, 18 May 54

Luleaa -- A snowstorm on 17 May made it impossible for the Gaellivare police to investigate the celestial objects which were recently seen in various places in northern Norrbotten Province. The police do not think that the objects were meteorological balloons but do not have any theories to account for the sightings. The latest eyewitness account was given by Valdemar Ylinentalo from Kuusijaervi, who declared that he saw a silvery football-shaped object coming from the Finnish side of the boundary; it had a fiery tail 70-80 meters long and appeared to descend to earth about half a kilometer from where he was. Jenny Karlsson, another eyewitness, stated that she saw a sphere-shaped object attached to a meter-long rod pass her at a distance of 4-5 meters [sic] and come to earth in the forest, a short distance from her. No traces of this object have been found.

CELESTIAL OBJECT TO BE DUG UP IN DENMARK -- Stockholm, Svenska Dagbladet, 24 May 54

In the near future, an investigation will be made to determine whether a flying object which landed in a field near Spjellerup about 6 months ago is a meteor, a shell, or some part of a "flying saucer." The object made a hole in the field about 3.5 meters deep and 25 centimeters in diameter and passed through a thick stratum of flint. The owner of the land pushed a long from rod into the hole and determined that the object at the bottom is metallic. It is said that at the time the object descended to earth, there were quite a number of unidentified flying objects over the area. Excavation of the object will be performed with assistance from the military.
