Министерството на външните работи на Република България поднася своите почитания на Посолството на Азербайджанската Република в София и в отговор на негова нота № AZ/N/020/16, от 19 януари 2016 г. има честта да го уведоми, че прелигането във въздушното пространство на Република България на 05 февруари 2016 г. от самолет Ил 76TD (reg.4K-AZ 101 alt. 4K-AZ101/ 4K-AZ 40/ 4K-AZ 41//4K-AZ 60, call sign AZQ 4142), собственост на азербайджанската авиокомпания "SILK WAY AIRLINES", свързано с изпълнение на товарен полет с продукция, предназначена за отбраната по маршрут Лайпциг-Мазари Шариф на 05 февруари 2016 г., се разрешава с дипломатическо разрешение № 194-15.

Полетът трябва да се реализира при стриктно спазване на правилата и процедурите за извършване на полети във въздушното пространство на Република България, регламентирани от българското законодателство и публикувани в "Сборника за аeronавигационна информация и публикация на Република България-AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION PUBLICATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF BULGARIA (AIP) и допълнително публикуваните NOTAMs) с цел актуализирането на аeronавигационната обстановка.

Дипломатическото разрешение е валидно 3 часа преди и 72 часа след заявените дата и часове за прелитане.

**EXEMPTION FOR TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY AIR**

Referring by paragraph 1.1.2 of Chapter I of ICAO Doc 9284 AN/905 (T.I.) and paragraph 1.2.6 of IATA DGR the Directorate General "Civil Aviation Administration" of the Republic of Bulgaria issues the following exemption for transportation of dangerous goods by air:

**FLIGHT DETAILS:**

**OPERATOR:** SILK WAY AIRLINES - Republic of Azerbaijan  
**AIRCRAFT:** IL-76TD  
**REGISTRATION:** 4K-AZ100 or substitute  
**FLIGHT NUMBER:** AZQ 4142  
**ROUTE:** EDDP/Germany - OAMS/Afghanistan  
**DATES OF OPERATION:** 05 February 2016  
**CONSIGNOR:** German Armed Forces - Germany  
**CONSIGNEE:** German Armed Forces - Afghanistan

**FREIGHT DETAILS:**

UN 0030/1 1B	Detonators, electric for blasting

**PACKED ACCORDING UN INSTRUCTIONS:** 130, 131, 135

**CONDITIONS OF EXEMPTION:**

- The Dangerous Goods must be packed in accordance with the relevant Packing instructions of ICAO T.I. and any applicable Supplement thereto.
- The Dangerous Goods category compatibility requirements must be strictly observed.
- Loading and unloading operations under this Exemption must be conducted only at a location, specified by the relevant Airport Authorities.
- The acceptance, loading, unloading and stowage of the said Dangerous Goods must be carried out in compliance with ICAO T.I. and any applicable Supplement thereto.
- All loading and unloading operations must be suspended during thunderstorms.
- Control over completion of shipping and other documents for the transportation of the Dangerous Goods, verifying the compliance of the cargo, packing and marking with ICAO T.I. requirements and other necessary activities must be conducted by certified personnel of Silk Way Airlines.
- It is recommended during the flight to avoid routes over densely populated areas.

- In case of any unscheduled landing at airport out of the specified flight route, the crew of the aircraft must immediately inform the responsible Airport Authority about the nature and quantity of transported Dangerous Goods.
- In case of any emergency situation onboard in connection with the transportation of this cargo by air, the crew of the aircraft must follow ICAO Emergency Response Guidance for Aircraft Incidents involving Dangerous Goods (Doc 9481).
- Any Dangerous Goods Accident or Dangerous Goods Incident, involving the transportation of dangerous goods by air, must be immediately reported to the Civil Aviation Administration.
- No persons shall be carried on board, other than members of the flight crew or employees of the shipper with functions related to the safe transportation of the said Dangerous Goods.
- This Exemption is revocable by the Civil Aviation Administration if necessary for safety reasons.
- The crew of the aircraft must be provided with written instructions, stating the conditions and limitations of the operations being conducted.
- The crew of the aircraft must have relevant training course on safety measures for transportation of Dangerous Goods.
- The insurance cover must be adequate to convey this nature of Dangerous Goods.
- This Exemption in no way affects the need of obtaining any required authorizations from the competent authorities of the countries of origin, transit and destination.
- All other regulations (marking, labeling etc.) of the ICAO T.I. (resp. IATA DGR) remain in force.
- A copy of this Exemption and all relevant documentation concerning the transportation of the said Dangerous Goods must be carried on board during the flight.

**THE EXEMPTION SHALL BE VALID FOR THE PERIOD: 05 - 26 February 2016**
