

- Control over completion of shipping and other documents for the transportation of this Dangerous Goods, verifying the compliance of the cargo, packing and marking with ICAO Doc 9284 AN/905 (T.L.) requirements and other necessary activities must be conducted by certified personnel of Silk Way Airlines
- It is recommended during the flight to avoid routes over densely populated areas.
- In case of any unscheduled landing at airport out of the specified flight route, the crew of the aircraft must immediately inform the responsible Airport Authority about the nature and quantity of the transported Dangerous Goods.

- In case of any emergency situation onboard in connection with the transportation of this cargo by air, the
  crew of the aircraft must follow ICAO Emergency Response Guidance for Aircraft Incidents Involving
  Dangerous Goods (Doc 9481).
- Any Dangerous Goods Accident or Dangerous Goods Incident, involving the transportation of this cargo by air, must be immediately reported to the Civil Aviation Administration.
- No persons shall be carried on board, other than members of the flight crew or employees or agents of the shipper with functions, related to the safe transportation of the said Dangerous Goods.
- This Exemption is revocable by the Civil Aviation Administration, if necessary for safety reasons.
- The crew of the aircraft must be provided with written instructions, stating the conditions and limitations of the operations being conducted.
- The crew of the aircraft must have relevant training course on safety measures for transportation of Dangerous Goods.
- The insurance cover must be adequate to convey this nature of Dangerous Goods.
- This Exemption in no way affects the need of obtaining any required authorizations from the competent authorities of the countries of origin, transit and destination.
- All other regulations (marking labeling etc.) of the ICAO Doc 9284 AN/905 (T.I.), resp. IATA DGR remain unaffected.
- A copy of this Exemption and all relevant documentation concerning the transportation of the said Dangerous Goods must be carried on board during the flight.

THE EXEMPTION SHALL BE VALID FOR THE PERIOD: 21 October - 21 November 2016
