Description	Described by Richard Dolan as "the most significant leak of UFO-related documents in many years." the Admiral Wilson documents, also known as the Wilson/Davis documents or EWD Notes, are 13 pages of notes written by Dr Eric Davis in October 2002 after a two hour meeting he recently had with Admiral Wilson during which they discussed UFOs, MJ-12, Roswell, crashed UFOs and alien bodies. They also include a copy of a two-page letter from Commander Willard Miller to Eric Davis dated April 25th, 2002 in which UFOs, UFO crash retrievals and Area 51 are mentioned. The documents were discovered among the personal effects of the late Edgar Mitchell who died in February 2016 although they may have been shown to some researchers earlier than that. These documents are a vital piece of evidence that the U.S military did retrieve a crashed alien spacecraft on at least one occasion; that highly secretive and unaccountable Special Access Programs (SAPs) were established with the express purpose of reverse engineering the craft in order to learn their technological secrets. Davis is the Chief Science Officer of EarthTech Int'l, Inc. and the Institute for Advanced Studies at Austin in Austin, Texas; and he is the Owner/Chief Executive/ChiefScientist of Warp Drive Metrics which does consulting and contracting for the Department of Defense. He is also an Adjunct Professor in the Early Universe, Cosmology and Strings Group at the Center for Astrophysics, Space Physics & Engineering Research at Baylor University in Waco, TX. Admiral Thomas Ray Wilson, born March 4th, 1946. He was the 13th Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) from 1999 until 2002. Prior to this position, from 1997 to 1999 he served as Director of Intelligence for the Joint Chiefs of Staff and Deputy Director of Intelligence for the joint chiefs, a position known as J-2. And the contractor...one of these corporate contractors...when he called them up, he said, 'I'm Admiral Tom Wilson...at that time he was Head of Intelligence for the Joint Chiefs of Staff... In advance of this important meeting we sent a document to his people. His assistant told me that the Admiral had, in fact, found these code names and code project names and numbers useful; he inquired through channels and found some of the ops in a cell in the Pentagon. Once Admiral Wilson identified this group, he told the contact person in this super-secret cell: "I want to know about this project." And he was told, "Sir, you don't have a need to know. We can't tell you." Now you can imagine being an Admiral, J-2, the head of intelligence for the Joint Chiefs of Staff, at the Pentagon, and being told, "We're not going to tell you"? Well, he was shocked and angry. Researchers have used the information provided by Greer, to determine that this meeting took place on 10 April 1997. On the Spaced Out Radio show, Cameron mentioned that at one point, he suggested you drop the material anonymously onto the Internet, but that you did not. Is this statement correct? May we again, hear directly from you whether or not you dropped the first two documents on to the Internet? A3. Grant did advise me on a video conference in early May, or thereabouts, that he wouldn't be dropping the documents. We did discuss as to whether I would drop them, and I said I wouldn't. I can categorically state that I did not drop the documents, or for that matter, pass them on to Richard Dolan. It is evident by mid-May there were a number of people in possession of the documents, along with several others that I know of who have had them for a decade or so. Q5. Richard Dolan mentioned that he was shown, what he believes were two pages of the Davis/Wilson document, in about 2006. In order that we can understand the timeline since 2002 when the Davis/Wilson document is dated, can you name the year in which you first came into possession of that document? A5. I was in possession of the documents for a few years before I showed them to Grant in November, 2018. He knows who has them and is keeping that person's identity private. I have been made to understand, however, that the acquisition of these papers occurred legally and above-board. I was also made to understand that this was a private initiative, not something orchestrated by any intelligence community. In other words, it wasn't an 'op.' Two segments with three frames each, one clearly showing the autopsy room, were given to Bob Shell, editor of Shutterbug magazine and also a phototechnical consultant for the FBI and the US courts. After a careful physical analysis, Shell confirmed the segments to be pre-1956 16-mm film. In 1956 Kodak changed its film-base from acetate-propionate to triacetate, and the samples were clearly on acetate-propionate film. The film type was Super XX-Panchromatic Safety Film, a high-speed film used for indoor filming but which had a life-span of no more than two years, when cosmic radiation would cause a 'fogging' of the material. Shell is sure the film was exposed and developed within two years. This, at least, dates the film as pre-1958. Ray Santilli already insisted on 5th May 1995 that the autopsies had been filmed on 1st and 2nd July 1947, and that the recovery had taken place "in the beginning of June"--one month too early for Roswell. I separated problem reels which required special attention in processing (these I would do later). The first batch was sent through to Washington and I processed the remainder a few days later. Once the remaining reels had been processed, I contacted Washington to arrange collection of the final batch. Incredibly, they never came to collect or arrange transportation for them. I called many times and then just gave up. The footage has remained with me ever since. In May of 1949, I was asked to film the third Autopsy.
