You asked me to research this UFO report to see if there were any AD involvement or interest.

AD ACTIVITY

- Have checked AD activity for the period 1700-1800hrs 6 Dec 96.
 The results are as follows;
 - -- <u>UKCAOC</u>. No record of AD activity in the region of the UFO report. Particularly, there was no QRA(I) activity, no routine night flying and no exercises in progress between those times.
 - -- RAF Buchan. RAF Buchan have no record of any AD activity in the area between those times.
 - -- RAF Neatishead. RAF Neatishead were not involved in any AD, exercise or air activity during the period of interest.
 - -- RAF Benbecula. RAF Benbecula were not involved in any AD or air activity during the period of interest.
 - -- RAF Coningsby. No RAF Coningsby ac ware flying that evening.
 - --- RAF Leeming. No RAF Leeming ac were flying that evening.
 - -- RAF Lauchars. No RAF Lauchars ac were flying that evening.
- Have checked discretely with Section 40 and the aircraft type operated on the Stornaway to Glasgow route is the ATP (turboprop).

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS ON REPORT

- Duration of sighting reported as 20 minutes. Aircraft position 40nm NW of Glasgow airport, inbound to Glasgow airport.
 - At 180Kts this aircraft would have travelled 60nm in 20 minutes, thus overflying Glasgow airport and travelling 20nm further away.
