1. I have investigated the UFO 'sighting' forwarded at Reference and can confirm that there was no air activity of Air Defence significance at the time reported.

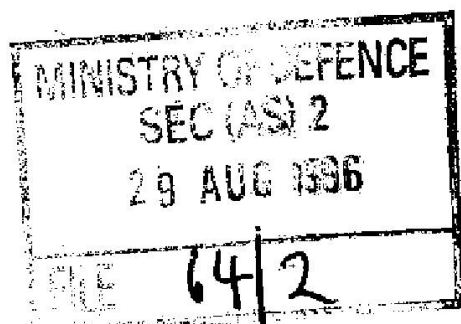

It is, indeed, unusual that this report was of some 40 minutes duration and from a reliable source, however, the estimated distance of the sighting, at 100 miles, is not consistent with visibility through the atmosphere at that range. Moreover, if you observed an object at 30 degrees elevation at 100 miles, it would be at an altitude of about 400,000 feet, well above the maximum height at which jet engines can operate...!

3. On a more down-to-earth note, I have discovered that a Nimrod aircraft recovered to Kinloss approximately 1 hour after this sighting and may possibly have conducted sea search operations or training beforehand in the Moray Firth area. Since I have already answered the exam question at para 1, however, I do not intend to investigate this option further unless you consider it particularly important,
