On Sunday, a response to VDU Serial 173 of that date I attended the home of a Section 40 in Alton. I there obtained a Statement in respect of this lady's sighting of an unidentified aircraft earlier this day.

- 2. I personally do not know this lady but my enquiries lead me to believe her to be level headed. She did explain that she was experiencing problems in her own private life leading to a certain amount of stress. She gave me the impression of being an absent-minded character who was somewhat embarrassed by her involvement in this matter. She appeared to me to be however, truthful and earnest in her observations. She explained that she had consumed only one glass of wine on this date and was taking no medication that would alter her perception of events. She did stress to me that she wished no publicity of any sort in respect of her statement.
- 3. The sighting appeared at 01.44 hours on Sunday, 21st September 1997 on the Ellastone Road when she was driving her own private car, travelling south east near to Cauldon Lowe. The grid reference is 073475. I personally know this area, there are no high voltage cables or transmission aerials to my knowledge. I did question Section 40 in respect of her attitude towards R.A.F. overflights. She explained that whereas she was not enthusiastic, she is not an inveterate complainor. There are regular flights in this area at a relatively low level by the R.A.F.
- 4. I ask that a copy of this report, together with the attached statement be forwarded to the person in charge Department of Trade and Industry, National Air Traffic Control Services, 1, Victoria Street, London SW1H OET for his information and attention.

I live at the address shown overleaf. On Saturday 20th day of September 1997 I visited an address in the Preston area arriving there at 18.45 hours. I believe I left Preston at around 23.45 hours. I was driving throughout this time. I drove onwards to Manchester, arriving there at 0.45 hours that following morning. I recall I left Manchester for my homebound journey at 00.50 hours. I would imagine that I arrived in Leek at around 01.30 hours. I was alone at this time driving my Peugeot motor car. I had the idea a short while before this, actually in Macclesfield, that my service brakes on my car were not 100%. Consequently I was driving somewhat slower than normal. I was wide awake as I was concentrating. The radio was on loud.

I left Leek at the Ashbourne Road, turning right at the Little Chef towards Windy Arbour. I travelled past the Green Man public house. The road at this location is straight and level. I think I had just passed a farmhouse on the left.

It was at this time that I became aware of, by sight only, a mauve/silver coloured, circular or oval shaped object, travelling at a very high speed from left to right. That's to say, from Cauldon Lowe towards Oakamoor. I would estimate it would be approximately twice or three times the height of a normal house. There was nothing in the background that I could gain a reference of in relation to the size of this craft. The craft was illuminated in some way. I did not see any protruderances, wings, cockpit, what have you.

The speed was very high. I am aware of the military aircraft that use this area to overfly. The speed of this craft was in excess of this. There were no markings on this craft that I saw. This craft did not change course of direction, I would say that I was viewing the craft at some 45 degrees.

I do wear glasses, but not for driving, I have good eyesight. It was a clear dry moonlit night. I heard no sound at all, however, the radio would prevent this. There was no smell at all. It was in within my view for a matter of seconds only.

The only building nearby was the farmhouse. I do not recall seeing any telephone or high voltage cables nearby. I did look at my car's clock which read 01.44 hours. I have no axe to grind in relation to low flying aircraft. I did not recognise this craft as anything I have seen before.

"UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS" - TUE 12 AUG 97 - POLICE REPORT

- 1. Sec(AS) has received yet another report of an "unidentified flying object" which was raised by a policeman.
- 2. I should be grateful if you would let me know if the report represents anything of air defence interest.



At 0100 hours Tuesday 12th August, 1997, I was travelling along the unclassified Corsham to Lacock road. I was in company with W.P. Section 40 We had reached a point just past the railway bridge, grid reference 894698, when an unidentified object flew past us in the same direction. I would estimate it's height at approximately 30 feet as it was just above the tree top level. The Police vehicle was travelling at 35-40mph and the object's estimated speed is 45-50mph.

Having passed us it then headed north east towards Chippenham. At this point it was joined by a second object which seemed to be following it. As they headed towards Chippenham their speed increased and were lost to sight of us within seconds.

The night was still and calm, visibility was very good and the Police Vehicle had it's windows down.

On seeing the objects the Police vehicle was turned left and the engine/radio switched off. At no point whilst in view of the objects could any noise be heard ie: rotor blades, engines, propellers.

I can only describe the object as triangular. It had two red lights on the rear, these were about 15 feet apart. The lights were ingular but approximately the size of a saloon car's headlights. On the front was a white light but it didn't give off a beam of light like a search light would. The thickness/shape or any other features of them could not be made out as the brightness of the rear red lights restricted us from seeing it clearly. RAF Lyneham contacted but they had nothing flying at that time.

Reported to Police from Section 40
was a helicopter following her home from Taunton at 0010 hours that day. Wiltshire
Police and Avon & Somerset Police were not using their helicoptors.

I have spoken with her and all she can say is she was followed home however she didn't get any description of the object and only saw a white light. No noise heard and was unable to estimate how far away from her it was.


