At 0100 hours Tuesday 12th August, 1997, I was travelling along the unclassiful Corsham to Lacock road. I was in company with W.P.c Section 40 we had reached a point just past the railway bridge, grid reference 894698, when an unidentified object flew past us in the same direction. I would estimate it's height at approximately 30 feet as it was just above the tree top level. The Police vehicle was travelling at 35-40mph and the object's estimated speed is 45-50mph.

Having passed us it then headed north east towards Chippenham. At this point it was joined by a second object which seemed to be following it. As they headed towards Chippenham their speed increased and were lost to sight of us within seconds.

The night was still and calm, visibility was very good and the Police Vehicle had it's windows down.

On seeing the objects the Police vehicle was turned left and the engine/radio switched off. At no point whilst in view of the objects could any noise be heard ie: rotor blades, engines, propellers.

I can only describe the object as triangular. It had two red lights on the rear, these were about 15 feet apart. The lights were ingular but approximately the size of a saloon car's headlights. On the front was a white light but it didn't give off a beam of light like a search light would. The thickness/shape or any other features of them could not be made out as the brightness of the rear red lights restricted us from seeing it clearly. RAF Lyncham contacted but they had nothing flying at that time.

Reported to Police from Melksham, Section 40 was a helicopter following her home from Taunton at 0010 hours that day. Wiltshire Police and Avon & Somerset Police were not using their helicoptors.

I have spoken with her and all she can say is she was followed home however she didn't get any description of the object and only saw a white light. No noise heard and was unable to estimate how far away from her it was.

I hope this is of some use to you..





The Ministry of Defence has no interest or role with respect to "UFO/flying saucer" matters, or to the question of the existence or otherwise of extraterrestrial lifeforms about which it remains open-minded. To date, however, the MOD is unaware of any evidence which proves that these phenomena exist.

The Ministry of Defence examines any reports of "UFO" sightings it receives solely to establish whether what was seen might have some defence significance; namely is there any evidence that the UK Air Defence Region might have been compromised by hostile or unauthorized foreign military activity.

The reports are examined, with the assistance of the Department's air defence experts as required. Unless there is evidence of a potential military threat, and to date no "UFO" sighting has revealed such evidence, we do not attempt to identify the precise nature of each sighting reported to us. We believe that down to earth explanations could be found for these reports, such as aircraft lights or natural phenomena, if resources were diverted for this purpose but it would be an inappropriate use of defence resources to provide this kind of aerial identification service.

REPORT OF AIRBORNE PHENOMENON

- Thank you very much for your call the other evening. Flt Lt has handed your report over to me and I have passed it on to the office at the Ministry of Defence which deals with such calls. Their task is limited to checking for a possible threat to the United Kingdom and if there was, you may hear from them in due course.
- The following suggestions are offered for your consideration rather than as a direct solution to your sightings. Since the object was static and appeared over several days, it was not the chance sighting of an aircraft, a helicopter or a satellite. Nor was it likely to be a reflection of lights from low clouds nor ionospheric effects. Although the conjunction of planets and stars can sometimes produce spectacular light shows, the only planets in the sky last week were Saturn rising in the east and Jupiter low towards the south. Nor were there any significant stars to the north. Perhaps the only logical item remaining is a balloon being flown repeatedly over the Yorkshire Wolds, but this again is not very likely.
- Certainly, RAF Fylingdales would have been unable to track a static object so close to the radar. I am afraid that there is little more to offer except to thank you again for your call.
