I expected it to be either the Police helicopter or a large transport aircraft heading for USAF Mildenhall - both familiar, especially the latter which we see daily. What made me give it attention was that there was no trailing light ray groundwards as is normal but more importantly no sound or vibration which again we are used to.

As I approached the place I climb through the hedge to cross the ditch the tall trees blocked my view. When I climbed through and across the ditch (less than 30 seconds) the light had disappeared. No sign of it and certainly no sight or sound of any aircraft. I know it was there because the two terriers with me saw it and started barking.

My partner was one orchard back with the other two dogs and saw nothing.



i would like to report a possible UFO sighting,

this evening my partner and i observed a bright object in the sky north of shrewsbury, shropshire. At approx 1805 hours we both stood and watched a bright light hovering in the sky directly north of us. We live in the herongate area of shrewsbury and at the time of the sighting the sky was clear with stars clearly visible. we have a direct view to the north with no obstructions.


the bright object seemed to be made up of 3 parts one of which was red in colour, this we both agree on. it seemed to move in a circular motion and from left to right randomly, during the time we watched the object, i saw 3 different aircraft transisting the sky in the area of the object. neither aircraft deviated from its flight path because of the object, but as the aircraft approached the object seemed to glow brighter and move more. i have seen the same object on numerous times in this area over the last few months, one sighting i witnessed was south of shrewsbury, and one was over the royal shrewsbury hospital. i know from experience this was not an aircraft or satelite as i do have some military experience and i have a great interest in aircraft which i am familiar with.

we watched the object for approx 45 minutes during in which time it operated in the same part of the sky. all the time the sky remained clear and free from cloud. at approx 1852 hours the object had completely disappeared. i would estimate that the object was at approx 10-15,000ft altitude and the size of a large bus or coach. i cannot be sure how far away it was but i would estimate that it was at a distance of approx 4 miles. this puts it in range of RAF shawbury which is in that general direction aswell.

both myself and my partner wittnessed this object and we both agree it was no aircraft and we both feel that what ever it was should be investigated and reported.



Tuesday 03rd November 2009. The object was first seen at 1920. This was viewed for approximately 12 minutes until 1932. The object was then not being viewed but was checked again at 1944, where it was still in place. Between 1944 and 1957 the object disappeared.

It has been described as one single object but full of lights. The lights have been described as a similar style to the fibre optic tube lights. 





My wife and I have just seen an amazing UFO over our home in Marlpit Hill, Edenbridge, Kent timed at about 8.45pm tonight.

The object was very bright yellow in the center surrounded by an orange outer edge and could be described as a fat 'boomerang' shape (stood on it's side) moving from slightly south of our home to the north west - disappearing in the distance over London. When my wife first saw the object she thought it had a fire-like glow inside - with some flame momentarily from one side (rather like an after-burner) but with no sounds at all. It was not a jet engine.

I estimate it was at an altitude of about 500/1000ft and traveling quite slowly for an aircraft - say 100/150 mph







I am not an astronomer of any description and was therefore wondering if you might be able to help me with a query as you undoubtedly have more expertise than I possess.

On the above evening I was driving from St. George towards shalington at a point in the road just before it curves round to the right about 1000 yards before the bridge which crosses over the Feeder river. A very clear and bright object which had a long bluish white light following behind it in the form of a narrow tail suddenly appeared to my left, travelling from (at a very rough guess) South East to South West. The object was in my clear line of vision through my windscreen for somewhere between 5 - 10 seconds. It was travelling at what seemed to me an incredibly fast speed and I have certainly never witnessed any other object moving with remotely the kind of speed this object was showing. In my observation, the object was in a gradual rather than a steep descent but was travelling at such a tremendous speed that I thought it would impact on the ground at some point to the South West of my viewing position. I have searched on the internet for any mention of another sighting but have not found anything to date. I am writing this email to report that on this night, 9th November 2009 at 19:23, both myself and my partner saw a flying object that we did not recognise.

The object was flying across plympton, Devon in a straight line. It was moving about three times as fast as a commercial plane move across the sky when at cruising altitude.

It was red and orange in colour, spherical in shape. It was about half the size of the moon as we are it and at first I thought it was a missile due to the fast speed and burning colour. It appeared not to make any noise but did appear to drop or have parts fall off of it which were a tenth of the size and same in colour.

I observed on Sunday 8th November 2009 - from 19:12 to 19:22 two orange lights moving slowly South, one leading. Their height was between 2,000 - 4,000 feet based on the type of cloud and at their distance apart as viewed from the ground would be about 20 feet, or the width of a normal single road viewed from 100 yards.

I'm pretty logical and at first thought they where distress rocket flares, but the colour was wrong. They did not flash, so not helicopters. No sound and as they were slow moving and coming towards me, not jet after burners. I thought balloons, but after a few minutes they slowly altered course and headed south east and the leading one started to accelerate up into cloud slightly opening the gap up. The other one followed and I lost sight as they went into the low level broken clouds.

I managed to capture a bit on my camera, but the lighting was on outside and the video recording is not very good!

Would it be possible for you to contact me or let me know if anyone else has reported this?

On the 1st of November at approximately 7.40 pm We were driving back from the Matlock area in Derbyshire. It was an extremely clear night, I had strong intuition that I should keep my camera with me, I sadly ignored that intuition and stuffed it into the boot. A decision that I would later regret heartily. We had driven for about 15 minutes when I became aware of a very bright light in the sky. Planes fly overhead all the time and I guess this night was no different than any other, except to say that the plane I saw seemed odd, it moved too slowly, considering how low in the sky it was. Moreover it was extremely low in the sky, helecopter low. It was pitch black outside the car so I could not get a good look at the plane.

what I can tell you though is that it's altitude stuck me as odd, as did its lights. it seemd to have one light in the middle and two constant lights on both flanks. It had a small blinking light underneath. As it flew low over Carsington water, I'd say it wouldn't have been more than 300 feet up at the very most. My real estimate would have been 100 feet. Now i'm not saying that this was an Alien spacecraft. Yet to me it was a UFO. UFO doesn't mean alien spacecraft that would be an ETV (Extra Terrestrial Vehicle). It was a UFO because it wasn't like any plane I have ever seen, it wasn't on a Flight path I have ever seen. It moved Slower than any commercial plane I have ever seen. What was it? I watched it fly over Carsington lake and then I lost sight of it for a few seconds, it was gone. Yet, I had a perfect view over the lake, as we climbed towards Kniveton near Ashbourne. Where did this low flying object go? I certainly felt unnerved. Rightly so. This part of Derbyshire, Matlock, Wirksworth, Bonsall is well known for its UFO reports, even more so lately. This year, 2009 has seen the highest incidence of UFO reports Worldwide since records began.

My partner who was driving the car, doesn't really hold with UFO's. I think she'd have to see one to believe it. She tends to express the view that there is a rational explaination for this sort of sighting and that there is no pooint making a fuss. This is the view help by the majoroty of the population. If fact I believe it too, except that I have long had an interest in UFO's because of very unusual things I have seen for years now.

On with the story. We drove on, I had now got a sneaking suspicion that we would see something else unusual. There seemed to be a lot of activity in the skies, but nothing quite as startling as what I had just seen. When we got to Uttoxeter, we were approaching the Mcdonalds roundabout when I became aware of a very large red light low in the sky. The red light seemed to be near to the Racecourse, it was at least 2 miles away though, so impossible to tell what it was, my partner also

w this. She looked a little spooked. I asked her to turn off toward the light but she declined and drove on towards Stoke on Trent. I couldn't help but feel that we had missed an opportunity to investigate. That said, having the family in the car probably wasn't the best UFO hunting opportunity. We drove on.

Then things got really good. As we approached Stoke on Trent down the A50. We were at the Britannia stadium when I looked across to my right (uk drivers side) and saw a very bright white light right over stoke town. I asked my partner what the hell it was, again she looked spooked and, again turned away from it opting to drive down to Newcastle via the Handford roundabout, much to my frustration, I wanted to try to get a photograph of this light. It was so bright.

As we left the Handford Roundabout the light became visible again. I pointedly asked her to look at it. It was a white light with tow smaller while lights on either side of it. As though on stalks or like spotlights. We could hear no Helecopter noise, even though my partner assured me that was what it was. As we drove along the A34 we were both looking at this light. It was definitely no more than 100 feet off the ground. Suddenly, and this is the best bit it changed colour from white to emerald green. Again, I alerted my partner to this, I said "look at it, tell me it has changed colour and I'm not imagining it". She confirmed that it had changed colour, the two small white sidelights seemed to have disappeared. At this point we were directly by the Tesco's at Trent Vale, and I could still see the object, I tried to get a photo. I took 2 and one caught a tiny bit of green glow...the image was very disappointing. Like so many UFO experiences I had failed to get any decent evidence and that truly is frustrating. Simply because 99% of all ufo photos are so inconclusive that nothing ccan be proved. Yet again my photos was certainly no different. If only I had kept the SLR in the front with me.




We arrived home minutes late and I scanned around and then went out for a drive to see if I could see anything unusual, I couldn't. What we did see that night though was 3 objects that were unusual. For once I had another witness who saw at least 2 of these objects.

I felt sure that this incident was so unusual I simply had to check it out. I called the Police that night to ask if the helecopter was up and flying in that region. they said they'd check and get back to me. No one got back. So I called again on Monday morning. I spoke with Staffordshire Police and asked them to check. They, recorded the incident (Trent Vale) and ran checks to see if the helecopter was flying. They called back to say that they had no record of the Police helecopter flying that night. this still doesn't mean it was an ETV, but it rules out police helecopters.

ther options could be military helecopters or the Air Ambulance. I called the Civil Aviation authority who told me that small aircraft do not have to register their flight plan with them. So I have thus drawn a blank. Whatever I saw looked weird to me. I'm keen to rule out check all conventional options. Yet I'd just like to say that what I saw in all three locations that night is consistent with current Ufo sightings across the country and the world. i enclose a poorly executed summary image of the craft I saw.

I too am sure there is a rational explanation, however, I did only report the incident to the MOD because I thought it was my civic duty to inform you. I hope I did the right thing.

With regards to your statement.

"The MoD knows of no evidence which substantiates the existence of these alleged phenomena."

The recent release of documents through the freedom of information act would suggest that the MOD certainly has lots of evidence to substantiate the existence of these "alleged Phenomena". The Rendlesham Forest Incident was so high Profile that no one with an interest in Unidentified Flying Objects could miss.

Former MOD official Nick Pope, and Lord Hill Norton, who was an Admiral, First Sea Lord and Chief of Defence staff certainly took a very great interest in UFO's and the (Rendlesham) case in particular. I Presume that given your quaoted statement, that you were unaware of the case.

Please, for the sake of public information re-word your response to such sightings. To say the MOD has no evidence of UFO's simply isn't accurate, and will certainly be held up to scrutiny by more articulate people than myself.

Ouote from Lord Hill Norton about his opinion regarding the Rendlesham Forest Case:

Lord Hill-Norton is a five-star Admiral and the former Head of the British Ministry of Defense who was kept in the dark about the UFO subject during his official capacities. In this short interview, he states that this subject has great significance and should no longer be denied and kept secret. He emphatically states, "...that there is a serious possibility that we are being visited — and have been visited for many years — by people from outer space, from other civilizations; that it behooves us to find out who they are, where they come from, and what they want. This should be the subject of rigorous scientific investigation, and not the subject of rubbishing by tabloid newspapers."

I know a good bit about the Bentwaters incident. I've interviewed a number of the people who took part in it, and what I have decided after careful thought, is that there are only two explanations for what happened that night in Suffolk. The first is that the people concerned — including Colonel Halt, who was, at the time, the Deputy Commander of the Base, and a lot of his soldiers — claim that something from outside the Earth's atmosphere landed at their air force base. They went and stood by it; they inspected it; they photographed it.

The following day they took tests on the ground where it had been and found radioactive traces; they reported this. Colonel Halt wrote a memorandum, which was sent to our Ministry of Defense. He has appeared on British television at least once, to my knowledge — possibly more often — in which he has repeated, effectively, what he said in that memorandum. What he said is what I have just described. That is one explanation — that it actually happened as Colonel Halt reported.

The other explanation is that it didn't. In that case, one is bound to assume that Colonel Halt and all his men were hallucinating. My position is perfectly clear — either of those explanations is of the utmost defense interest. It has been reported and claimed — and I, myself, have raised it to ministers at the Defense Ministry in this country — that nothing they have been informed about regarding UFOs is of defense interest. Surely, to any sensible person, either of those explanations cannot fail to be of defense interest. That the Colonel of an American Air Force Base in Suffolk and his military men are hallucinating when there are nuclear-armed aircraft on the base — this must be of defense interest.

And, if indeed what he says took place, did take place — and why on Earth should he make it up — then, surely, the entry of a vehicle from outer space (and certainly not manmade) to a defense base in this country also cannot fail to be of defense interest. It simply isn't any good for our ministers — and the Ministry of Defense in particular — to say that nothing took place that December night in Suffolk, or that it is not of defense interest. It simply isn't true.

Since my name has become connected with UFO matters in quite a big way in this country, and in one or two other countries too, I have frequently been asked why a person of my background — a former Chief of the Defense Staff, a former Chairman of the NATO Military Committee — why I think there is a cover-up, or what the reasons may be for government's wishing to cover up the facts about UFOs. A number of explanations have often been put forward. The most frequent, and perhaps the most plausible, is the government's concern (which [is] primarily that of the United States, and that of my own country) over the public's reaction if they [were] told the truth — which is that there are objects in our atmosphere which are technically miles in advance of anything that we can deploy, that we have no means of stopping them coming here, and that we have no defense against them, should they be hostile.

I believe governments fear that if they did disclose those facts, people would panic: people would rush about and jam switchboards like they did that famous day in New Jersey, when there was a spoof that the Martians [had] landed — people will go mad, and they will jump up and down. I don't believe that at all — I've said so in print. I do not believe that people today, in the 21st century, are going to panic at that sort of information. After all, they have put up with the introduction of nuclear weapons and the destruction of two Japanese cities 50 years ago. They take as a matter of course that we can land vehicles on Mars — land to the precise instant, forecast years before. So why should they panic? They are much more interested in doing the pools or the lottery. They would shrug their shoulders and take it as a matter of course. Anyway, they don't trust politicians, in my experience.

What I'd like to say is that there is a serious possibility that we are being visited — and have been visited for many years — by people from outer space, from other civilizations; that it behooves us to find out who they are, where they come from, and what they want. This should be the subject of rigorous scientific investigation, and not the subject of rubbishing by tabloid newspapers.


It seems to me that the Bentwaters incident is a classic case where an apparent intrusion into our airspace — and indeed, a landing in our country — occurred, which was witnessed by serious-minded people in the military — responsible people, doing a responsible job. And, Bentwaters is, in a sense, a benchmark for how not to deal with these matters in the future.

I should add that to date, the MoD knows of no evidence which substantiates the existence of these alleged phenomena.



I am writing with reference to your report of an 'unidentified flying object', seen on 7 November 2009 over Colchester. I have been asked to reply as this office is the focal point within the Ministry of Defence for correspondence relating to UFOs.

Firstly, it may be helpful if I explain that the Ministry of Defence (MoD) examines any reports of 'unidentified flying objects' it receives solely to establish whether what was seen might have some defence significance; namely, whether there is any evidence that the United Kingdom's airspace might have been compromised by hostile or unauthorised air activity.

Unless there is evidence of a potential threat to the United Kingdom from an external source, and to date no UFO report has revealed such evidence, we do not attempt to identify the precise nature of each sighting reported to us. We believe that rational explanations, such as aircraft lights or natural phenomena, could be found for them if resources were diverted for this purpose, but it is not the function of the MoD to provide this kind of aerial identification service. It would be an inappropriate use of defence resources if we were to do so.

The MoD does not have any expertise or role in respect of 'UFO/flying saucer' matters or the question of the existence or otherwise of extraterrestrial life forms, about which it remains totally open-minded. I should add that to date, the MoD knows of no evidence which substantiates the existence of these alleged phenomena.

UFO Sighting Details.txt on 07/11/2009 at approximately 19:20 whilst standing outside our flat in Colchester while my husband was having a cigarette we saw 4 slow moving round orange lights in the sky moving from south east to north east. The first light appeared and looked like a really large orange ball of fire which was faintly pulsing. It emitted no sound and was travelling in a very straight line I watched it move away into the distance and as it was moving away I saw the rear end of the UFO and it seemed to have not a single light behind it only a bright orange light on the front. They were moving quite slowly almost like a slow plane but somehow seemed completely different and very strange like nothing we have ever seen before. we then saw another light exactly the same as the first one about 1 minute later following the exact same path it looked and behaved exactly the same as the first one. Neither of them emitted any sound at all they were completely silent. This time I tried to record the UFO on my camera phone but I was not quick enough and missed it. I kept my phone out just in case any more lights came past. Then 1 minute later another light exactly the same as the previous two came past, following the same course in the sky except this time there was another light (which was the same as all the others) following close behind it and we could see two of them in the sky at once. Because I had my camera phone out still I managed to record both of the lights and when we looked at the video after the lights had disappeared the UFOs seemed to be pulsing and changing colour they seem mainly white on the video but they seem to change colour through all the colours of the rainbow. we told our neighbour who came down for a cigarette himself a few minutes later and he said that he had seen something exactly the same but he had seen 7 or 8 of them all close together. we saw the first one at about 19:20 and saw the last one at about 19:25.







A neighbour saw a similar sight on the same evening at 2130, but in the Western sky, at an elevation of about 50 degrees above the horizon.


Some friends in Hunstanton (35 miles to the East of us) saw a similar object at 1730, again proceeding on a northerly course.

I trust that both of you are the correct personnel to help with my enquiry. If not I would be grateful if you would forward this email to correct personnel.

Please find below a UFO eye witness statement that I have submitted to the UK UFO SIGHTING website. The first object detailed below was a helicopter, however, I would like you to see if you can provide any explanation or identify the second craft that was seen by myself on Saturday night [31st October 2009]. I assure you that this is not a hoax.

"Incidents occurred over Winchburgh, West Lothian between 7.30 to 8.30 pm - two incidents are described, one was definately a helicopter but the other craft could not be identified.

The two events happened within an hour - at about 7.30pm heard rapid approach of a helicopter - could have been Police chopper as I have seen this flying over area but usually during daytime. It finally came into view (standing in my back garden which faces west) and heard / saw obvious chopper but could not distinguish make. Engine sounded different to police chopper although it was flying much lower than normal. Saw navigation lights and curiously the whole underside of the helicopter cabin was illuminated in a white light (was not the searchlight - this was actual underside of craft that was illuminated). This passed over and flew away flying generally from west to east. Came inside, had dinner then after clearing up went outside again for some fresh air and glad I did.

An object, flying VERY low, came into view about three houses along to my right. I could not make out full body but using red lights it seemed to be cylindrical and as wide as an ordinary helicopter. This object came from south east flying in general direction of north west toward Blackness / River Forth. Three things I noted: (1) it was totally silent, (2) it had two large red navigation lights on body with one on top and other on bottom but placed

diagonally opposite each other i.e. bottom left and top right from angle I was viewing object, and (3) was moving VERY slowly, infact, almost drifting. Object in full view (at an angle) for only about seconds. Regretted not driving to chase object as i had went upstairs to rear bedroom to see if i could gain a better view. By this time object had gone behind trees on the small west facing embankment but could still see the flashing red strobe lights - one strobe went then the other went off in a repeated set design (i.e. lights did not operate randomly). Object was then

lost from view. Would like to state that it could not have been a plane as it would have stalled due to the very low speed (estimated 5 to 10 mph). Helicopter possible but why no noise - not aware that choppers can be slienced at such a low altitude, as object could only have been a couple of hundred feet off the ground.... if that (note it came in very low, just above double storey rooftop level). There was no noise, no vibration and no electro-magnetic interference as far as i could see (house lights stayed on, did not flicker etc).

Noted on other recent reports that drones (presume man made unmanned aircraft) were reported in skies above Edinburgh area and this is a possibility, but why fly them at such a low altitude and over populated areas? There was no further sign of the chopper after this incident, but noted a commercial aircraft on final approach to Edinburgh Airport coming in from roughly the southwest may have had object in sight. Have emailed Edinburgh Airport and RAF Leuchars to see if they can shed any light on this incident."

On 3rd November 2009 at approximately 19:00 – 19:10 my mother and I were sat in our living room when my mother casually pointed out an object in the sky. We both thought it was a firework to begin with, as we had seen others earlier in the evening.

On stepping out of my chair and looking at the object I realised it was not a firework. My next reaction was to identify the object as something like a balloon or lantern. I went outside and the object was quite low, and appeared hollow with a bright orange light inside of it. At this point it was moving at the speed a balloon would in a strong gust of wind, but was picking up speed. It was so low it seemed as though it had been let off outside in someone's back garden.

It was no plane or helicopter, as the object was silent

I tried taking a picture on my phone but could not get a view; the object was out of sight until I went into our back yard to see where it had gone.

The object had continued in the same direction but had gained considerable speed and height. It was going up at an angle and was literally picking up speed in front of our eyes. The shape appeared more triangular the further it got away. By the time I stepped into our back conservatory to get a pair of binoculars the object was becoming a small dot on the horizon in the sky.

I live in a small village outside of Pontefract. By the time it disappeared it was heading in a northeasterly direction, over towards the A1 motorway. We back onto open countryside, so we had an unrestricted view of this object disappearing into the sky.

Firstly, it may be helpful if I explain that the Ministry of Defence (MoD) examines any reports of 'unidentified flying objects' it receives solely to establish whether what was seen might have some defence significance; namely, whether there is any evidence that the United Kingdom's airspace might have been compromised by hostile or unauthorised air activity.

Unless there is evidence of a potential threat to the United Kingdom from an external source, and to date no UFO report has revealed such evidence, we do not attempt to identify the precise nature of each sighting reported to us. We believe that rational explanations, such as aircraft lights or natural phenomena, could be found for them if resources were diverted for this purpose, but it is not the function of the MoD to provide this kind of aerial identification service. It would be an inappropriate use of defence resources if we were to do so.

The MoD does not have any expertise or role in respect of 'UFO/flying saucer' matters or the question of the existence or otherwise of extraterrestrial life forms, about which it remains totally open-minded. I should add that to date, the MoD knows of no evidence which substantiates the existence of these alleged phenomena.
