

Special forces began clearing the city of Bucha in the Kyiv region, liberated by the Armed Forces of Ukraine, from saboteurs and accomplices of Russian troops. This was reported in the National Police.



"Currently, the city has soldiers of the Safari National Police Special Purpose Regiment, which includes representatives of special police units, KORD and Thor fighters, as well as specialists of the Explosives Service," the agency said.

The police said that the specialists of the explosives service are inspecting the sites of war crimes in Russia, as well as seize explosives and ammunition that did not detonate. Law enforcement officers say they are inspecting every yard and shelter, communicating with residents and helping them. "Citizens who have survived the horrors of the occupation are doing their best to help law enforcement. city ", - noted in National police.
