

The perpetrator of the murder of Dugina decided to put on the international wanted list

Ukrainian citizen Natalya Vovk, who is the perpetrator of the murder of political scientist and journalist Daria Dugina in the Moscow region, will be put on the wanted list with a view to subsequent extradition to Russia, law enforcement agencies said.

“Citizen of Ukraine Vovk Natalya Pavlovna, who disappeared in Estonia after the execution of the murder of Darya Dugina, will be put on the wanted list for the purpose of extradition,” law enforcement agencies told [TASS](#).

Earlier, the FSB reported that the murder of Dugina was [prepared by the](#) Ukrainian special services, the performer is a citizen of Ukraine Natalia Vovk, who fled to Estonia.

It is specified that in order to organize the murder of Dugina and obtain information about her lifestyle, Vovk and her daughter rented an apartment in Moscow in the house where the journalist lived.

They watched Dugina from a Mini Cooper car. At the same time, when entering Russia, the numbers of the Donetsk People's Republic were used - E982XH DPR, in Moscow - Kazakhstani numbers 172AJD02, and when leaving - Ukrainian numbers AH7771IP.

Recall that on the evening of August 20, an explosive device went off in a Toyota Land Cruiser car moving near the village of Bolshiye Vyazemy, Moscow Region, after which the car caught fire. It was established that the explosive device [was planted](#) under the bottom of the car on the driver's side. Daria Dugina, who was driving a jeep, [died on the spot](#). [A criminal case has been opened](#) on the fact of the murder of the girl (clause “e” part 2 of article 105 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation), it will be investigated by the central office of the RF IC. According to investigators, Dugina's murder was planned and ordered.

The official representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Maria Zakharova, stated that if the version of the “Ukrainian trace” in the case of the murder of Dugina is confirmed by the competent authorities, then we can talk about the policy [of state terrorism](#) on the part of Kiev. At the same time, the Ukrainian authorities [declare](#) that they were not involved in the murder of Dugina. The father of the deceased, political scientist Alexander Dugin, in turn, [spoke](#) about the threats that he and his daughter received from Ukraine.
