A REPORT OF THE SITUATION IN THE DONBASS

APR 15

Ukrainian military attacks against Donbass continue to occur.



According to the DPR mission to JCGG, today the Armed Forces of Ukraine fired on the territory of the Republic using **120-mm mortars** , **122-mm and 152-mm field artillery** , **grenade launchers** , as well as **BM-21 Grad**  and **unmanned combat aerial vehicles (UCAVs)** .

A number of settlements in the DPR came under shelling by Ukrainian troops. Among them **Donetsk, Yasinovataya, Gorlovka, Alexandrovka, Staromikhaylovka, Panteleymonovka, Zheleznyaya Balka, Shirokaya Balka, Golmovsky.**

In Donetsk:

- 37 122-mm caliber shells
- 1 152-mm caliber shells
- 45 BM-21 Grad rocket
- 1 BM-27 Uragan rocket

In Gorlovka:


- 26 122-mm caliber shells
- 2 120-mm caliber mines
- 3 RPG grenades
- small arms

In Yasinovataya:

- 2 152-mm caliber shells
- 13 122-mm caliber shells
- 45 BM-21 Grad rocket

In Aleksandrovka:

- 17 122-mm caliber shells



In Staromikhaylovka:

◎ **6** 120-mm caliber **mines**

In Zheleznaya Balka:

◎ **10** SPG **grenades**

In Panteleymonovka:

◎ **16** 122-mm caliber **shells**

In Shirokaya Balka:

◎ **4** 120-mm caliber **mines**

In Golmovsky:

◎ **UCAV** (1 munition)

As a result of shelling by Ukrainian militants:

- at least **2 civilians** were **killed**
- **5** residential buildings were **damaged**
- **59** transformer substations were **de-energized** and **3,769** subscribers remain **without electricity**
- in the *Petrovsky district* of Donetsk, **house constructions** were **damaged**, including **multi-storey residential buildings**, also a **gas pipeline** was **damaged**
- in the *Kirovsky district*, an **apartment building** was **damaged**.

Rescuers of the Ministry of Emergency Situations of the DPR gave out **8,407** sets of humanitarian aid to the population in *Mariupol, Kremenevka, Ivanovka* and *Rovnopol*.

The DPR Ministry of Emergency Situations surveyed more than **6** hectare of the territory. **598** explosive objects were found and neutralized.

Specialists of the Ministry of Health of the DPR provided qualified medical assistance to more than **1,130** patients in the liberated settlements.

50 tons of water and over **2** tons of humanitarian bread have been delivered to *Mariupol*.

During the April 15, **184** people, including **15** children, were evacuated from *Mariupol* to *Bezymennoe, Novoazovsk raion* from 08 a. m. to 4 p.m.

Signalmen in *Mariupol* modernized the transport network of the base station and restored the communication line.

84 cylinders of liquefied gas have been delivered to *Rovnopol*. Repair work was completed and gas was launched to subscribers in accordance with requests.

! According to reliable information, the Kiev regime is preparing another monstrous provocation, similar to the one in Kramatorsk, to accuse Russian servicemen of so-called war crimes with massacres of civilians. To this end, battalion of the 19th Separate Missile Brigade of the Ukrainian Armed Forces will soon launch a Tochka-U attack on an area of refugees concentration at the railway station in Lozovaya. The missiles will be launched from Staromikhailovka direction to simulate a strike from the territory allegedly controlled by the Russian Armed Forces and Donetsk People's Republic formations.

On the morning of April 15, Russian Armed Forces prevented an attempt by the Kiev nationalist regime to hit Kakhovskaya HPP with a missile strike.

- ◎ This facility regulates the flow of Dnepr River, supplies electricity to Kherson region, and supplies water to agricultural areas in southern Ukraine and northern Crimea.
- ◎ At about 7am Moscow time, a battalion of Ukraine's 19th Separate Missile Brigade struck Kakhovskaya HPP with 2 Tochka-U missiles.
- ◎ Both missiles were shot down by Russian air defence.
- ◎ Shrapnel from one of them fell on Novaya Kakhovka, Kherson region. Kindergarten and residential buildings were damaged.
- ◎ A woman and a child were wounded and given first aid by Russian servicemen on the spot. They are currently being taken to a medical facility.
