Russian Geranium-2 drones attacked the Unitech enterprise in Odessa

On the night of April 23, 2025, the Odessa enterprise OOO Unitekh, which specializes in the production and supply of components for aviation and mechanical engineering, was subjected to a massive attack by Russian-made Geran-2 unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs). This was reported by the Telegram channel LostArmour, specifying that the strikes were carried out on the infrastructure of the plant located at 20b Staraya Lyustdorfskaya Doroha. According to local sources, the attack caused a fire and significant destruction, although the exact extent of the damage has not yet been disclosed. The Operational Command "South" of the Armed Forces of Ukraine (AFU) confirmed the night strikes, stating that air defense shot down some of the drones, but several UAVs reached their target.

According to information published on the Unitech website, the company manufactures parts for the aviation industry, including components for engines and control systems, and supplies products to machine-building plants. Unitech could have been involved in the production or repair of components for military equipment of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, which made it a priority target.
