The Civil Aeronautics Board has received from Mr. Stefan Dwojak, an alien currently residing in the United States, a request for a waiver of the citizenship requirements of the Civil Air Regulations for the issuance of an airman's certificate.

Before taking action upon such request, the Board desires to have information concerning Mr. Dwojak's conduct prior to entering the United States, as well as subsequent to such entrance, in order to be assured that he is not a person who might owe allegiance to an unfriendly foreign government and in some way take improper advantage of the privileges of his airman's certificate.

Accordingly, the Board would appreciate your conducting a name check of this individual and advising whether or not your files contain any information which might indicate that Mr. Dwojak owes allegiance to such an unfriendly foreign power.
