Reference	Conversation between SSD, and SR,7 August 1952

- 1. For the past number of months mail bags containing copies of SUCHASNA UKRAINA (published in Germany) have been delayed at Idlamild Airport by Customs, allegedly because this newspaper is suspected of pro-Communist tendencies. The SUCHASNA UKRAINA, organ of the Foreign Representation of the Ukrainian Supreme Council of Liberation (ZPUHVR), is an anti-Communist publication and is recognized as one of the outstanding Ukrainian newspapers in the emigration. Any information to the contrary which Customs has may stem from political opponents of ZPUHVR, or it might conceivably be a Communist provocation. Since SR cam vouch for this publication, it is requested that your Division investigate this matter in order to uncover the true reasons behind the delay as well as to determine who the individuals or organizations are who have originated these alleged accusations.
- 2. Since 1948, SR has been successfully cooperating with the ZPUHVR in its effort to infiltrate the Soviet Union. ZPUHVR an emigre group represents the Ukrainian Supreme Council of Liberation (UHVR) which is the underground Ukrainian government within the Soviet Union opposed to and actively combatting the Communist regime. SUCHASNA UKRAINA is the emigre publication which reflects this anti-Bolshavist struggle of the UHVR and its military arm, the Ukrainian Insurgent Army (UPA).
