Subject: SUCHASNA UKRAINA - Ukrainian Language Bi-Weekly

1. For the past number of months mail bags containing copies of SUCHASNA UKRAINA (published in Germany) have been delayed at Idleswild Airport by Customs, allegedly because this newspaper is suspected of pro-Communist tendencies. The SUCHASNA UKRAINA, organ of the Foreign Representation of the Ukrainian Supreme Council of Liberation (ZPUNVR), is an anti-Communist publication and is recognized as one of the outstanding Ukrainian newspapers in the emigration.

2. Since SR is interested in giving this publication a wide circulation, it is requested that your Division investigate this matter in order to uncover the true reasons behind the delay, as well as to determine who the individuals or organizations are who have originated these alleged accusations.
