a. Authority:

AERODYNAMIC Project Outline approved 5 June 1953 by DD/P in the amount of [ ]

b. Operational Objectives:

The purpose of Project AERODYNAMIC is to provide for the exploitation and expansion of the Anti-Soviet Ukraine resistance movement for cold war and hot war purposes. Such groups as the Ukrainian Supreme Council of Liberation (UHVR), its Ukrainian Insurgent Army (UPA), the Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists (OUN), all in the Ukraine, the Foreign Representation of the Supreme Council of Liberation (ZPUHVR) in Western Europe and the U.S., and other Ukrainian organizations such as OUN/B, etc., will be utilized.

Political warfare:

To continue to subsidize the Ukrainian language newspaper SUCHASNA UKRAINA as part of our assistance to the Ukrainian resistance organization ZPUHVR/UHVR and utilize the newspaper as a medium for promoting the unification of the major Ukrainian emigre groups as well as inserting articles along line of current U.S. Psychological Warfare Program required scripts and tapes.

Accomplishments:

(1) The Study Group has produced two studies which are currently being reviewed by PP/staff personnel.

(2) Thru the Ukrainian newspaper SUCHASNA UKRAINA the two major Ukrainian political groups are being unified in one identical stand in line with Homeland directives.

(3) The radio scripts are now being written up and the first tapes for broadcasting into the Ukrainian SSR should be ready within a month.

(4) Up to winter 1953-54 we were in W/T contact with two agents in the Ukrainian SSR from whom we received info which should help unify the two major groups ZPUHVR and OUN/B

Psychological Warfare:

(1) Utilization of the Soviet Study Group, under auspices of ZPUHVR, for the purpose of supplying CIA with information on the Ukrainian SSR and its Communist leadership.

(2) Support the Ukrainian underground in order to enable it to continue waging psychological warfare against the Soviet Regime in the Ukrainian SSR.

(3) Initiate black radio broadcasts into the Ukraine SSR utilizing the Study Group for the production of radio scripts for broadcasting into the Ukrainian SSR.
