SUBJECT; Procurement of Safehouse by Safehouse Procurement Section

1. On 13 May 1954 the undersigned was notified by [] of Safehouse Procurement that in a day or so he would be in NY to arrange for a safehouse for the Study Group and that a real estate agent had apparently been cleared for use in aiding him obtain the necessary house. Since some member of the Study group would look over the property located by [] the Undersigned was requested to furnish information to [] as to how he could get in touch with this study group member. For this reason, the following information was exchanged: [] to be known as [] would call the Study Group Office at Monument 3-8461 and ask for George Lopatinsky and arrange to meet George in order to look at the house and arrange for the lease if the house turned out to be suitable for the purpose required.

2. The following briefing was given [] regarding his association with George Lopatinsky: a) The undersigned was known to George as Mr. Steve. b) [] was told why the house was needed and the type required; c) he was told in general what the study group was engaged in; d) [] was told not to engage George in a discussion of the Study group or the tentative use of the house, radio scripts, etc. or in other words, not to show any knowledge of the work by the group.
