1. I have read the enclosed papers and might comment as follows:-

- a. The plan is ambitious, and worth a good try.
- b. Does its realization require additional finance burdens from us?
- c. Some names are garbled:- Roman ILNYTSKY (not ILINSKY); I imagine Prof. ~~KACHMED~~, etc. is one man only; Eugene ~~PRITSAK~~ is a young Ukrainian turkologist (protege of Prof. ~~KRYMSKY~~ OF Kiev); Dr. B. ~~KORDUK~~ aka KORDYUK is apparently the Ukrainian scholar, member of AEDHUMMER 1, who worked in the Near East before World War II.
- d. It seems that the planned magazine should be closely guided from our side insofar as ideological approaches and perfection of language are concerned.
