a. Action Reported:**a) By Field:**

1. The Ukrainian newspapers ("Suchasna Ukraina" and "Ukrainsky Samostiynik"), in addition to their regular output, started the publication and distribution of special editions to the newspapers. One of the special editions is devoted to the review and analysis of economic problems and questions concerning the Soviet-Ukraine as a part of the USSR. The other one, called a Literary Gazette, is devoted to the review and analysis of the trend in contemporary Ukrainian literature. Publicizing of the contact with the Ukrainian underground, which was arranged on a wide scale in Europe and the United States, has resulted in widespread attention of public opinion to the problems and sufferings of the Ukrainian people under Soviet rule. The Soviet internal colonialism and the Soviet treatment of nationality questions regarding the minorities within the USSR provide a strong basis for an important political action, which is being developed by the Ukrainian emigre circles. In connection with this nationalistic drive, and the spread of the Soviet influence in the Middle East, the Ukrainian emigres in Germany are engaged in publishing an English language publication based on the material produced by Prolog Associates, and are planning to distribute this publication throughout the Afro-Asian country.

b) By Headquarters:

1. The production of radio scripts for daily 15-minute broadcasts through PYREX Station are continuing. The results of the political appeal to UNO launched last month are being utilized by the arrangement of public meetings throughout the USA and Canada in which the suffering of the Ukrainians in Soviet concentration camps would be publicized.

2. Contact with the Ukrainian group in Spain and the arrangement for taking over the Ukrainian broadcasts from Radio Nacional (Madrid) are continuing. Mr. Marcus, who is scheduled to take over Radio Nacional for Prolog Associates, is expected to arrive in the USA in the near future. His personnel data has been received and his clearance is being processed.

3. A detailed report on the situation in Argentina regarding the repatriation to the USSR has been received through Prolog Associates, and a sum of \$500.00 has been allotted for the support of the Ukrainian repatriation anti-Soviet activities in Buenos Aires. A copy of the report (at the request of Mr. Vaivada) will be forwarded through WH [] Buenos Aires Station, and a clearance on Mr. Malecky, a representative of Prolog Associates [] is in process.

4. The problem of utilization of contacts opened up via possibilities of sending packages to the USSR has been investigated for the purpose of establishing channels of information and propaganda. A detailed investigation of these possibilities has been undertaken.

5. Action has been started for collecting information and analyzing the possibilities offered by the increase in the church activities in the USSR. The Ukrainian Church is divided into two branches; one of them is the Greek Orthodox Church in Eastern Ukraine, and the other one is a Greek Catholic Church in Western Ukraine. The relaxation of the controls in contact between the Soviet Church and the Free World offers certain possibilities for utilizing these channels in matters of propaganda against the Soviets, and these channels are being scrutinized and investigated for practical operational purposes.
